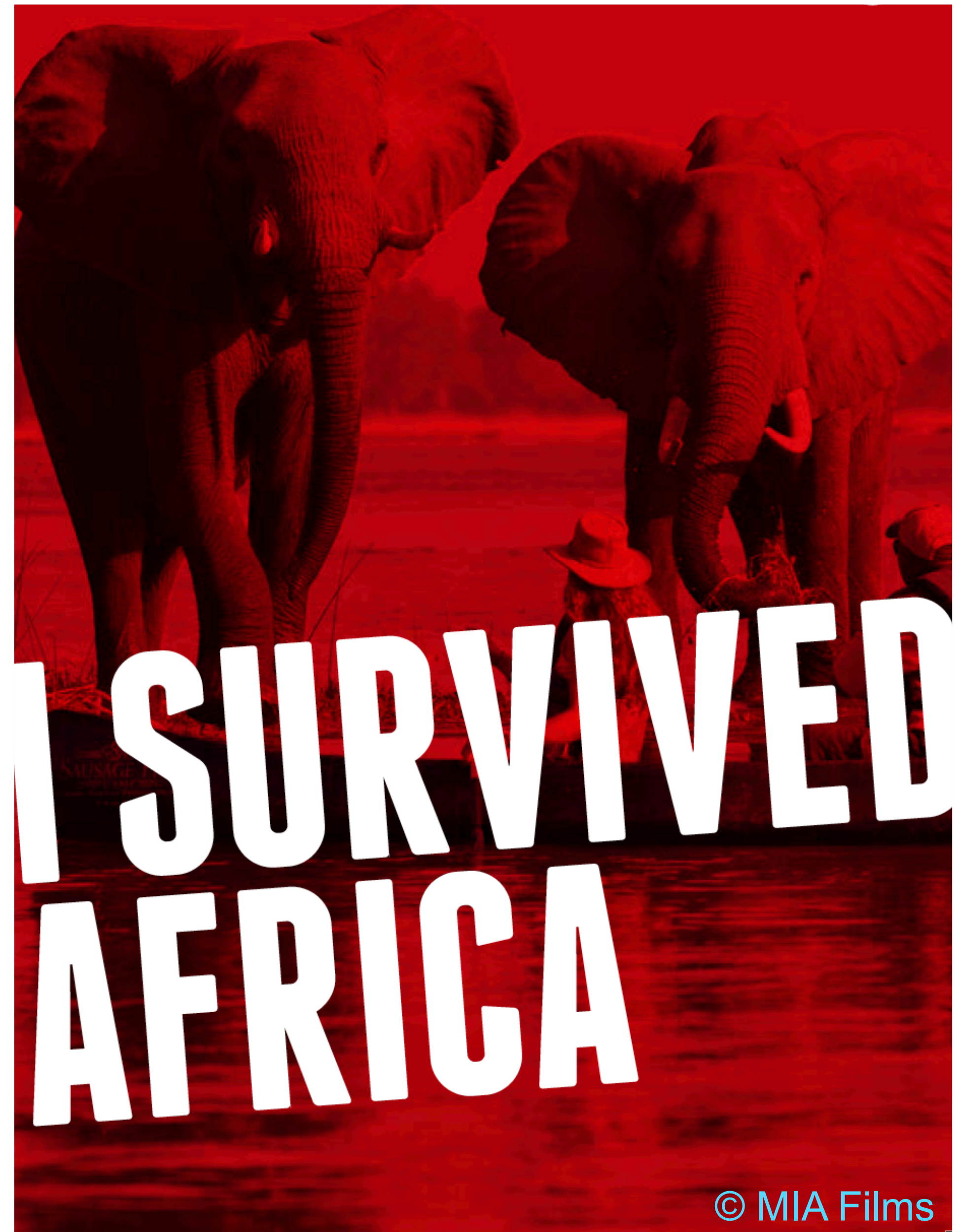
# EXOTIC VETS

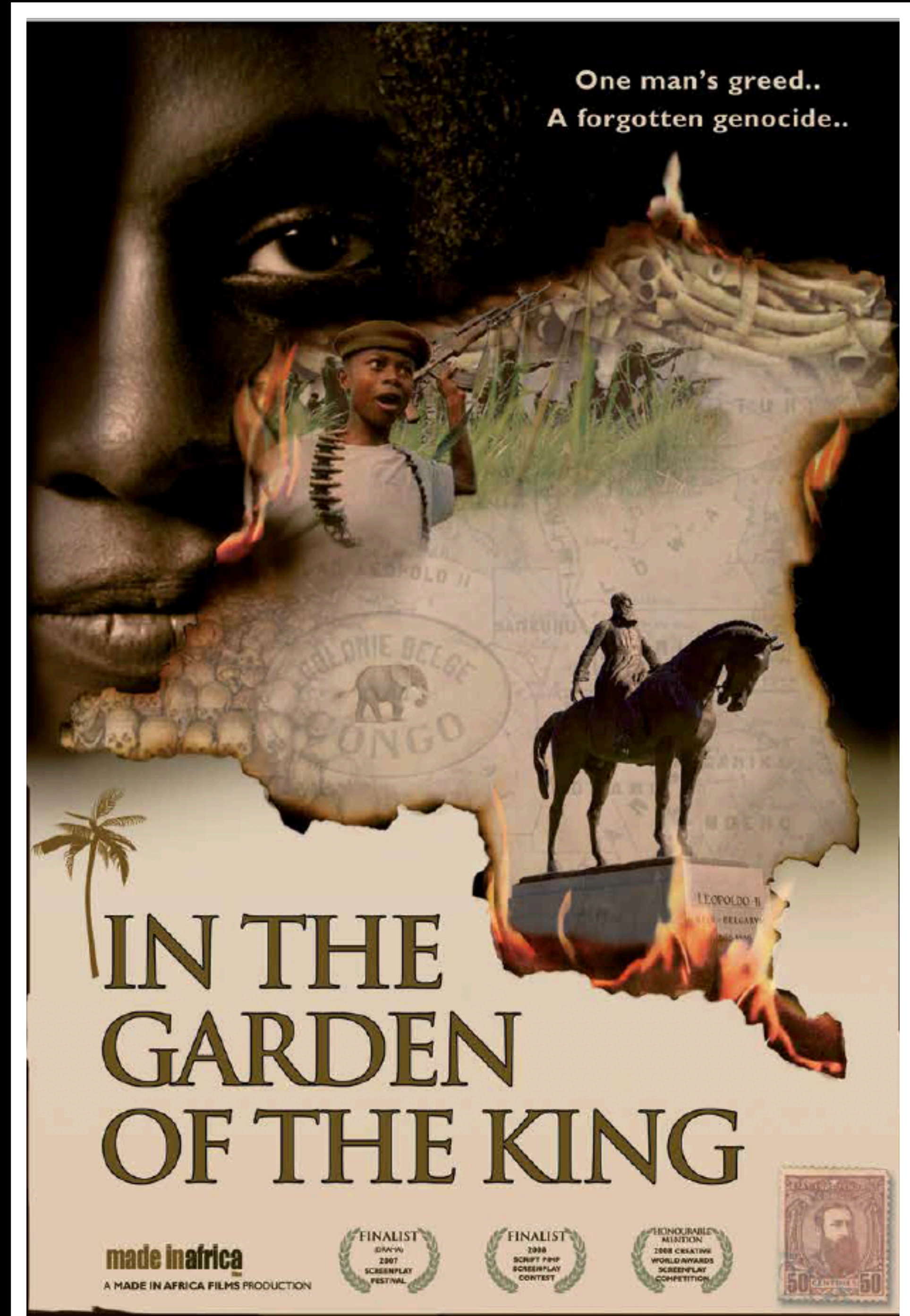
# IN THE GARDEN OF THE KING

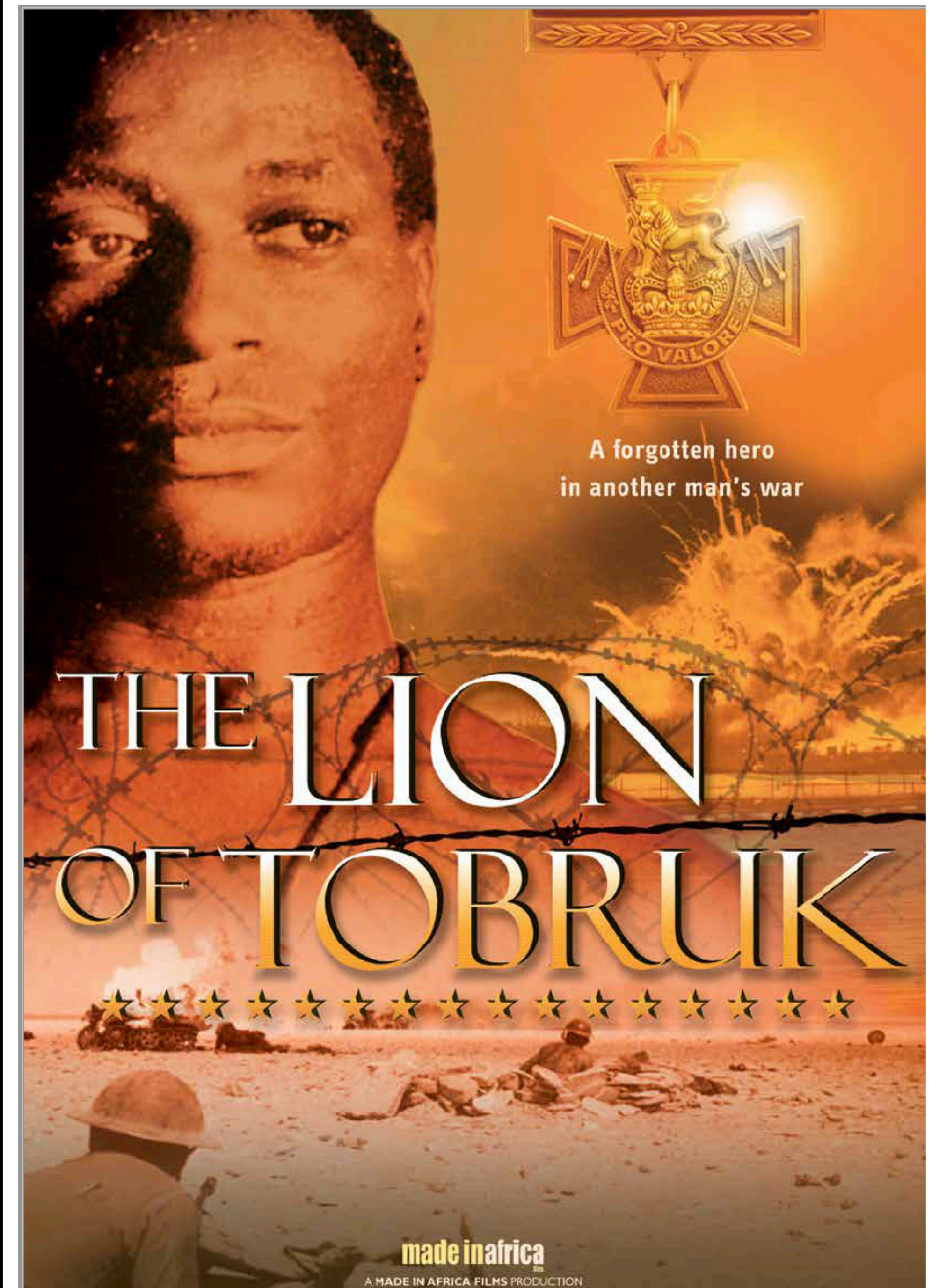
# THE LION OF TOBRUK
