Older homes can be beautiful, but unfortunately, not a safe place for elderly or disabled veterans to live in. Our “Aging in Place” program works to keep Veterans in their own homes, if possible, through ADA modifications such as wheelchair ramps, stair lifts and bathroom modification. We also assist in home safety repairs as many Veterans do not know where to reach out for help. We strive to help Veterans find reliable resources to keep their homes safe and livable.



## HEARTH & HOME

This is our flagship program. We provide Veterans with a safe home of their own. We remodel homes for Veterans coming out of homelessness as well as find financial and job counseling to help them become a whole, productive citizen once again. Many homeless Veterans are moved from shelters into empty apartments by other agencies. We help provide these Veterans with furniture and appliances.

## WINGS OF VALOR

One of the major obstacles for a Veteran obtaining the help they need is transportation. Our handicap assessable van allows us to help these Veterans get back and forth to their crucial appointments at no cost to the Veteran.



Food insecurity is a threat to many of our Veterans. Ride with Valor helps combat this by teaming with our community partners to distribute food parcels to Veterans in need. We distribute holiday meals to Veterans, both at home and those in shelters. Ride with Valor also operates its own orchards. We work with our partners to distribute fresh produce to Veterans in need, something that may ordinarily be unaffordable.
