Edmonton's Best Summer Activity

We provide the lifejacket, paddle, river tube and shuttle service. You just have to show up.

Edmonton River Float was launched to provide people in the Edmonton area a favorite summer

activity. Nothing is better on a hot summer day, than spending it on the river and seeing Edmonton from a new perspective.

Our home base and meeting spot is at Rafters Landing ([Google Map Link](#)), by the Muttart Conservatory. This is where you will check in, and board the shuttle. The shuttle will take all floaters up river to Laurier Park Boat Launch, where your tube will be waiting. Once on the river, you can sit back, relax, explore and enjoy the view. Once you complete the float, and arrive back at Rafters Landing, staff will be available to assist in exiting the river where you will return your tube and gear. Safety is our top priority, but having fun is a close second. Don't miss out on Edmonton's best summer activity. **BOOK NOW**

FAQ

How do I reserve my float?

We highly recommend booking online, as we do sell out. **BOOK NOW**

Floats can also be reserved on-site at Rafters Landing, on a first come first serve basis.

What safety information should I know?

Children 12 years and younger should be accompanied by an adult at all times on the river. Life jackets and paddles are provided and are recommended for everyone, especially if you are a weak or inexperienced swimmer. You must exit the river at the designated exit point (rafters landing) and are responsible for doing so. There are no lifeguards on site, and all floaters enter and exit the river at their own risk. Staff safety demonstration is provided before entering the river.

All non-swimmers and anyone not comfortable around open water should not float the North Saskatchewan.

What is included?

We provide round trip shuttle service and everything you need to have a fun and safe time on the river. All floaters will receive round trip shuttle service, a premium tube complete with backrest and cup holder, lifejacket, paddle, safety demonstration and fun.

What should I bring?

While it is possible to float without getting wet, we recommend bringing water activity clothing and footwear. Drinking water and a ziplock/dry bag to keep valuables dry are also encouraged. Some nice to haves are snacks, coolers with ice, music and a towel.

Note we do sell refreshments, and merchandise at Rafters Landing.

Where are you located?

Edmonton River Float's home base is at Rafters Landing ([google map link](#)). You will see our tent and staff. Even if you're not floating, come by and say hi! This is where everyone must check in, and meet the shuttle. Please arrive at Rafters Landing 15min before your scheduled shuttle. The shuttle brings floaters up river to Laurier Boat Launch ([google map link](#)). This is where you will enter the river. Exiting the river back at rafters landing.

What time should I arrive?

If you booked online, which we recommend, you must show up at rafters landing 15min prior to your scheduled shuttle. This will give you time to check in, ensure documentation is completed, and grab your gear. If you do not have a reservation, you should arrive at Rafters Landing 30min prior to a scheduled shuttle to see if we have availability.

Where should I park?

There is parking right at Rafters Landing. If the lot is full, you can use the Muttart Conservatory parking lot across the street, or residential parking and walk over to the check in tent.

How long does the trip take?

Float times vary depending on a number of factors including river flow, and amount of paddling done during the float. The average float time is 3 hours, plus the 20-30min shuttle. Last floats of the day are limited to 3.5 hours, and encouraged to stay in the current.

What happens if I miss my shuttle?

You are required to arrive 15min prior to your shuttle to prevent delays. If you miss your scheduled shuttle, staff will try to accommodate you on our next shuttle but not guaranteed.

How do I complete the waiver?

EVERYONE that is floating is required to fill out a waiver. In your confirmation email that you receive after reserving your float, you will see a waiver link. This link can be forwarded to everyone in your party to sign. It is highly recommended that your entire group fill this out prior to arriving on site. Floaters 18 years or younger, will require a parent or guardian to sign the waiver for them.

Are lifejackets required?

While lifejackets are not legally required, we highly recommend them especially for children. We provide life jackets for everyone that wants one. For children 8 and younger, we have a limited number of small life jackets, and encourage you to bring your own when possible.

What do I do if there is bad weather on the day of booking?

The weather is unpredictable, and we really want to be on the river when it's nice out. Our general rule is that we float when there's no rain. If rain is forecasted, our team will reach out to reschedule your float or provide a credit.

Is the North Saskatchewan River safe to float down?

With any water activity, no matter how safe the river, you must be alert at all times. Main things to be aware of on the river. Other water crafts, we share the river with many others including motor boats and other paddlers. Be aware of other boats, and try to give them lots of room. The next thing we want to be aware of are the bridges, during your float, you will go under SIX bridges. Do your best to float through the middle of the bridges and keep away from the bridge pillars. The North Saskatchewan River is generally considered a safe waterway in the summer months. We prioritize safety, so if you have any questions or hesitations please speak with staff or contact us ([link to contact us](#)).

What are the terms and conditions?

What happens if I miss the exit point?

Once you pass under the Walter Dale bridge, floaters need to make their way over to the right side of the river (opposite of downtown). Right after the low level bridge, you will see the Edmonton River Float flags, and staff. This is the required exit point. If you miss this point, you need to paddle quickly and exit at Accidental Beach, then walk back to the check in. If staff are needed to be dispatched to retrieve a floater or tube that missed the exit, a non-negotiable \$50 fee will be charged.

What is your cancellation policy?

We have a 48-hour cancellation policy. Those canceling 48 hours prior to their reservation will receive a full refund. Those canceling under 48 hours prior to their reservation will receive a credit that can be used at a later date. "No Shows" will be charged the full rental rate.
