WINES OF CHILE

Chilean wine, has a history dating back to the 16th Century. During the last decades, renowned international wineries have flocked to Chile, bringing investment, modern winemaking techniques and expertise, to create a winemaking revolution. Today, Chile is an acclaimed producer of fine wines with vast areas planted with premium grape stock.

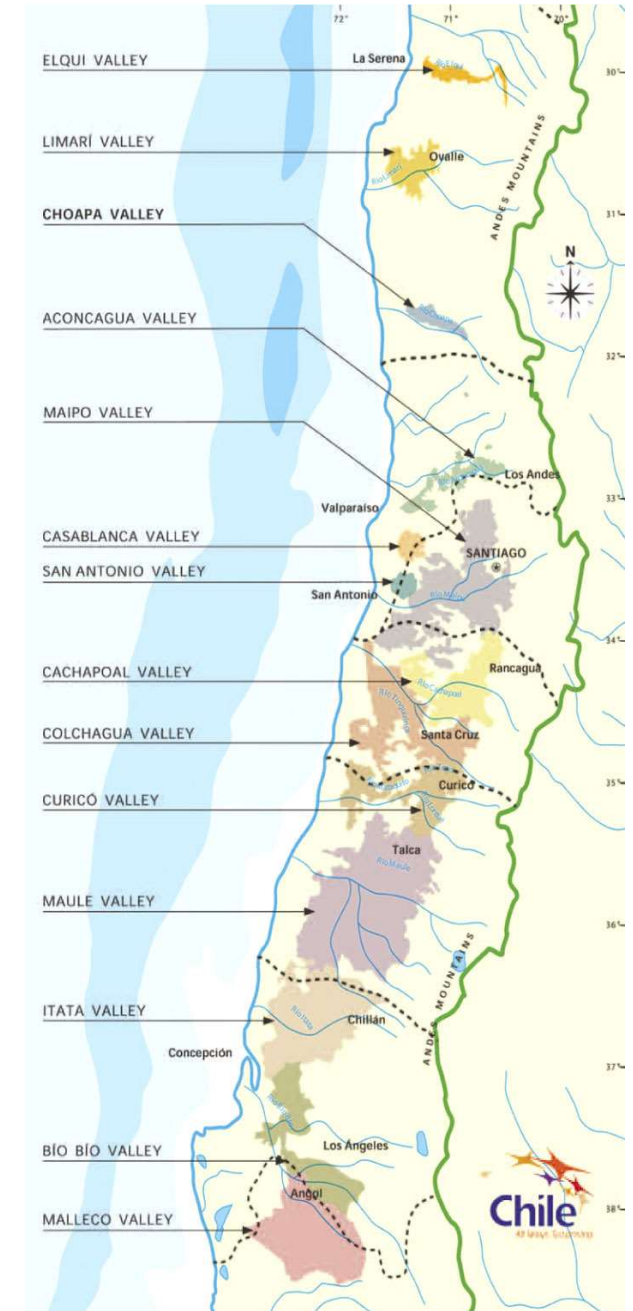
This thin and long country has remarkable geo-climatic conditions for winegrowing. The Atacama Desert to the north, the imposing Andes Mountains to the east, the Pacific Ocean to the west and the temperate rain forest to the south all provide natural barriers that keep the country's vines free from pests and diseases. There are two particular features which are unique to Chile's climate: cold currents from the ocean and the influence of the Andes, both of which regulate temperatures. Chile's wine valleys also possess just the right mix of soil, sunlight exposure, temperature and humidity conditions resulting in an exceptional terroir.

Chilean Carmenere, wine with charm

Carmenere is today Chile's own signature grape. This red varietal originated in Bordeaux (France), a variety from the Cabernet family that was extensively cultivated in France in the middle of the 19th century. This was before phylloxera destroyed practically all the cultivation in Europe, and the Carmenere variety virtually disappeared from European vineyards.

It reappeared among Chile's Merlot vines one hundred years later. It became apparent, only in 1994, following a discovery by Claude Valat and Michel Boursiquot that actual plantings of Carmenere existed among some Merlot plantings. As a result Chile was able to enhance its reputation as being able to produce a style of wine uniquely associated with the country, as California is associated with the production of Zinfandel, Australia with Shiraz, Argentina with Malbec.

The deepest, darkest shade of all red grapes require a long growing season to reach its fullest potential. It has aromas found in red fruits, spices and berries. The tannins are gentler and softer than those in Cabernet Sauvignon and it is a medium body wine. A very pleasing and easy-to-drink wine.

Viña Carmen is considered Chile's first winery, established in 1850 by Christian Lanz. Ever since then it has been ahead of its time in many ways, and most notably was the first winery to create and sell a Carmenère wine back in 1996. In 1994 on 24th November, French ampelographer Jean Michel Boursiquot was visiting the vineyards of Viña Carmen when he spotted that the vines of Merlot looked remarkably like Carmenère, which was then considered almost extinct after disappearing from France following phylloxera. It was this discovery in Carmen's vineyard that led to the emergence of Carmenère as one of the most important grape varieties in Chile.

Argentina is the fifth largest producer of wine in the world. Its wine industry is reaping the benefits of its heritage - old vines, unique geographical conditions, new technology and a mix of modern and traditional methods. It has come a long way since the first vines were planted in Mendoza more than 400 years ago. The oldest vineyard was planted approximately 65 years ago and each parcel is primarily comprised of sandy soils with elevations ranging from 1650 to 1900 metres above sea level. All grapes are hand harvested, working with Tannat, Torrontes, Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Syrah along with some small plots of additional varietals. The winery is currently run by Lucia Romero-Marcuzzi, the granddaughter of Roberto, the founder of El Porvenir de Cafayate.
