# WINERY FOCUS



Paisley is a small textile town in Scotland, just outside of Glasgow. It was the birth town of Kirsten's Great x 4 Grandfather who emigrated to Adelaide in 1839. The town became famous for making women's shawls in the 1800s in the boteh

pattern, the pattern we now know as paisley. Thinking about all the fun they could have with their packaging and product names, Paisley Wines was born.

Paisley believe the secret to great wine is only using fruit from exceptional sites. Some of the best vineyards were selected for their wines to ensure they can produce the style they wish to make.

In the 2018 vintage they expanded to include the fruit from two new growers, along with some fruit from the Angaston vineyard they purchased in April 2018. The Angaston vineyard consists of 12 acres of Shiraz and they are planning to plant some more Shiraz and Mataro vines on their spare block in spring. Watch this space!

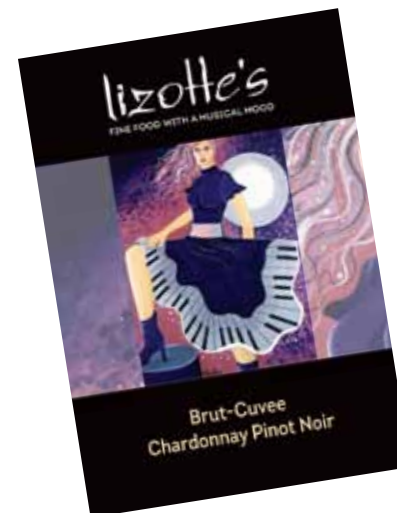

# CHAMPAGNE GARDET

## Montagne de Reims, France

Champagne Gardet is a medium sized and family-owned company that was created in 1895, when Charles Gardet founded his establishment in Epernay. In the 1930s, Georges Gardet, son of the founder, moved to Chigny-les-Rosés, a premier Cru-ranked village in the heart of the “Montagne de Reims”, with a very precise aim: to develop the Champagne Gardet brand, whilst continuing to supply wines of unimpeachable quality.

To do so, he based his method on the secular champagne making rules: a high-quality grapes supply and a wine making process fully oriented toward excellence. This purpose and the respect of tradition are still at the heart of the current owners’ preoccupations: the PRIEUX family. Deeply attached to their roots, the Champagne region, the family has been working in the arboricultural and agricultural sectors for years; passing on their love for their land from generation to generation.

Champagne Gardet is the 20th House of Champagne (in volume), with an annual production of approx. 1 million bottles. The greatest care is taken to produce high quality products by leaving the champagnes on the lees in the vaulted cellars for the longest possible (way over the legal requirement) and by being one of the few Houses still using oak barrels to age part of the reserve wines.

For more than four generations, the Piñol family's love of the land and vineyards has enabled them to develop world-class grapes used to produce the high quality wines that they sell around the world today. Combining traditional winemaking methods with state-of-the-art technology ensures their exceptional wine quality.

# DE ALTO Rioja, SPAIN

Rioja is a large region and, like Champagne and the Douro, is dominated by a small number of very large branded producers whose size dictates that they buy-in grapes and bulk wine from a large number of growers and cooperatives.

deAlto believes that one of the strengths of the region is the diversity and potential of its vineyards but, by definition, large brands are not best placed to express this.

deAlto crafts wines which we believe to be individual, pure expressions of the Rioja Baja vineyards that we call home.

We were very lucky that the Manzanos family shared our ideals and through that relationship, we have access to over 250 hectares of prime Rioja vineyards from which we select only the best for deAlto.

One of the traditional obstacles for any grape grower wanting to become a winemaker in Rioja was that to become a Bodega, one had to own a certain number of barrels. Today, the entire classification system is based around the notion that ageing in barrels equates to quality.

Once part of the Venetian Republic and with sections under the influence of the Austro-Hungarian Empire for some time, the wines of the North-Eastern Italian region of Friuli-Venezia have noticeable Slavic and Germanic influences. The climate is distinguished with very warm days and chilly nights that help maintain a balance in the grape between acidity and sugar levels and allows the grapes a long, slow growing season.

# CLOAK & DAGGER King Valley, VIC

Cloak is a brooding Sangiovese, while Dagger is a bright and lively Pinot Grigio, two exciting Italian varietals from Victoria's King Valley.

Callie Jemerson and Nina Stocker believe that winemaking doesn't have to have barriers but what it does need is quality, focus and a destination. "We love creating something that brings a twinkle to the eyes of others..."

Stocker and Jemmeson have learnt from their trade in places as diverse as Portugal, Italy, France, America and New Zealand. The pair have been great friends and partners in wine since meeting in 2009. Their Freedom of expression and unbridled thinking is celebrated in every wine they produce.

Cloak has a nose and palate of wild raspberry, ripe cherry and spice, with notes of cacao, bramble, coffee and earthy flavours. Dagger is an exciting Pinot Grigio. A balanced palate of Corella pear, honeysuckle, nashi pear and lemon verbena, with a tight acidic backbone and beautiful length.
