# ARGENTINA

There is a palpable sense of community in the Argentine culture when they come together to eat, drink, and relax. Their wines are a reflection of this – each bottle is a celebration in itself, made that much more enjoyable when shared with others.



## Location

Along with Chile, Argentina occupies the southern most part of South America. Mendoza is located in the west central area of the country at the foothill of the Andes Mountain Range, the tallest mountains in the world outside the Himalayas. Mendoza is the most outstanding and prestigious viticulture region in Argentina, producing the vast majority of the country's wine. In fact, more wine is produced in this region than in the whole of Australia!

## Culture

Argentina is well-known for Tango, Football (Soccer), and Parrilla (BBQ). However, it is much more than that. It is an incredibly diverse country with an indigenous culture combined with influences of a strong Spanish, French, and Italian heritage that is evident in the passion of its people, the food, and especially in the production of their wine.

## Terroir

With more than 300 days of sunshine a year, low annual rainfall, and high altitudes, Mendoza provides near perfect conditions for the growth of wine grapes.

The land in this area is essentially a desert. The Andes create a 'rain shadow' with much of the rain falling on the Chilean side of the mountains. One thousand years ago, the native Huarpe Indians built an irrigation system to channel the pristine glacial waters of the mountains to the desert area of what became Mendoza, creating an oasis to be used for farming. This irrigation system is still used by the winemakers of Mendoza today, giving them greater control over the growth and maintenance of the vines. The dry climate means the vines are less susceptible to mould and rot that could not only damage the vines, but also affect the flavours and aromas of the wine they produce.

Mendoza's high altitude causes large fluctuations in day and night time temperatures resulting in grapes that ripen slowly to produce highly flavourful wines with good acidity.

## Argentina has grown to be the 5th largest producer of wine in the world.

### Winemaking

With a history of viticulture dating back to the 1500s when the first vine clippings were brought over by Spanish settlers, Argentina has grown to be the fifth largest producer of wine in the world.

Winemaking began with the production of wine for Mass by Catholic monks in the early 16th century. It then rapidly accelerated in the 19th century when European immigrants brought their knowledge and experience in wine elaboration and introduced grape varieties such as Malbec, Cabernet, Merlot, Chardonnay, Pinot, and Semillon which thrived in the varied Argentine terroir and microclimates.

### Malbec

The increasing demand for fine wines in the late 20th century caused a shift in Argentine winemaking that now sees it producing some of the most spectacular New World wines.

Though originally from southwest France where it is used primarily for blending, the Malbec grape found its ideal environmental conditions in Argentina for the production of exceptional wine. Mendoza is considered the best producer of Malbec in the world and it continues to be its greatest export variety.

Malbec is distinguishable by its intense, dark colour and fruity aromas. In the mouth it is warm and silky, and presents non-aggressive tannins. It is a perfect partner for grilled red meats, pasta with red sauces, hard cheeses and chocolate.

### Torrontés

It is unknown when the Torrontes grape was introduced into Argentina, however, Torrontes, like Malbec, has found its natural home in the Argentinian terroir. With very little Torrontes being produced outside Argentina, it has become the country's emblematic white varietal. Although it is grown in various winemaking regions in Argentina, sitting at an elevation, the cold, dry climate of Salta is considered the best region for the cultivation of Torrontes grapes.

The wine is pale yellow in colour with floral aromas that suggest sweet flavours; yet in the mouth a refreshing acidity balances the fruit flavours. It is perfect as an aperitif or paired with fish and seafood. It also pairs surprisingly well with the spicy foods such as Indian, Thai, and Chinese cuisines.

### Bonarda

Bonarda is Argentina's second most cultivated red variety. There is still much confusion about the origin of Argentine Bonarda. Recent research by French and Argentine ampelographers has now shown that Argentine Bonarda is most likely the rare French grape Corbeau from Savoie and may be related to California's Chabono.

Most Bonarda is currently planted in vineyards in the eastern region of Mendoza. This region has a dry, warm and sunny climate, relatively deep alluvial soils, and abundant water for flood irrigation. Bonarda grows vigorously under these conditions, and careful vineyard management is required to avoid over cropping and dilute, low quality fruit. Bonarda is thin skinned, has tight clusters, and is susceptible to rot, so the dry desert-like conditions in eastern Mendoza help maintain healthy fruit.

The most common style is one that is easy-drinking and juicy, offering aromas and flavours of black cherry, raspberry and plum. Wines in this style are generally dark in colour with a velvet texture and round tannins. Bonarda is a best friend to Italian cuisine, pork dishes, hard cheeses, and rich, chocolatey desserts.

The winery is in Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza and the vineyards are located in Vista Flores, in the area called Valle de Uco, 1,050 metres above sea level. Yield is very low, ranging between one or two bottles per plant, providing a stronger concentration of aromas, colour and very soft tannins.

Mauricio Lorca specialises in crafting premium unoaked wines that offer the full expression of fruit and terroir. The Opalo and Gran Opalo lines are unoaked.

At the foot of the Andes Mountains, at the turn of the millennium, the Spanish family Ortega Gil-Fournier founded a small 'boutique' winery in La Consulta. The La Consulta region is located in the well-known Valle de Uco, approximately 1200 metres above sea level. At this altitude, there is a significant fluctuation between day and night-time temperatures. This variance is particularly favourable to the production of wines with excellent colour and suitability for long ageing in oak barrels.

# CHILE

## Culture

Chile is a prosperous and forward-thinking country with a strong economy and numerous free-trade agreements. As a result of decades of sustained growth, Chile enjoys a diverse economy based on mining, forestry, agriculture, fishing, tourism and, of course, wine!

Several of our wine producers reference artwork in their marketing from the native Mapuche, the indigenous inhabitants which still represent nearly 5% of the total Chilean population.

## Terroir

In the 16th century, the Spanish Conquistadors found the ideal place to plant vines. The local soil was free of phylloxera and the climate allowed a perfect growing season and ripening time for fruit.

By the mid-19th century, the first major change to Chilean wines began to take hold. The economy - strongly based on agriculture and mining - had matured and wealthy businessmen started looking to France as a model. Rich families

travelled abroad where they explored French wines and châteaux. Excited by the possibility of replicating them back at home, they imported a selection of the finest rootstocks to Chile, just a few decades before the phylloxera outbreak that devastated the Old World. In Chile, these rootstocks grew own-rooted, and turned out to be valuable genetic material. This also allowed for Carménère to thrive hidden amongst Merlot for over a century, even after it became extinct in France.

## Winemaking

The Chilean winemaking style reflects age-old techniques with traditional French and Spanish roots. However, the modern Chilean winemaker utilises modern technology and employs pioneering methods to overcome the challenges they encounter as they explore and develop exciting new growing regions. The industry focus on sustainable winemaking practices is truly exemplary with modern wineries being built with sustainability at the forefront of their design process.

## Sauvignon Blanc

Famous world wide for their Sauvignon Blanc, the distinctive Chilean style falls somewhere between the mineral style of the Loire Valley and the distinctive tropical character of New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc. “Zesty” is the buzz word and nothing makes a better aperitif than a glass of bright, young Sauvignon Blanc. Highly aromatic and featuring citrus fruit tones of green apple and crisp pear with a refreshing green-grassy aroma that is complimented by a stoney, steely, mineral edge. It can be enjoyed by itself but is also incredibly food friendly. Pair with prawns, white fish, salads or blue cheese.

## Cabernet Sauvignon

Chile's star grape, the king of all reds, Cabernet Sauvignon also made its way from France in the mid-19th century. It quickly settled in and began enticing local, and later international, consumers with its powerful attributes.

Although it grows in all but the coldest of Chilean climates, this late-ripening grape truly flourishes in vineyards in Aconcagua, Maipo, Cachapoal, and Colchagua regions, where the warm, dry climate allows it to ripen thoroughly and develop rich red fruit, berry, blackcurrant, and fig aromas and flavours. Some areas, such as Alto Maipo, have a distinctive eucalyptus edge that lends freshness. More complex versions often feature notes of tobacco, chocolate, black tea, black olive, liquorice, tar, coffee, graphite, incense, and leather.

Chilean Cabernets are distinctive in themselves and often feature a characteristic “jubeiness” on the nose and palate, as well as fantastic length that makes them not only wonderful when paired with food, but a true pleasure to drink on their own. Incredibly versatile, pair them with most food or even try with chocolate or berry based desserts.

## Carménère

Chile's own signature grape, this red varietal disappeared from European vineyards in the mid-19th century and reappeared among Chile's Merlot vines a hundred years later. The deepest and darkest of all red grapes, it demands a long growing season to reach its fullest potential. Examples are usually rich in berry fruits and spice (think blackberries and black pepper), with smooth, well-rounded tannins. The generous fruit and soft tannins make this a very pleasing and easy-to-drink varietal. Enjoy it with red meats and corn-based dishes, such as the Chilean favourite pastel de choclo (corn and meat pie), or take advantage of its natural fruity spiciness and serve it with a mild curry or even with Mexican dishes.

## AMAYNA

Established in 2002 in the San Antonio Valley which runs parallel to the central valley of Chile, an ideal location for the production of cold climate grapes. The winery architecture was inspired by the rolling hills found between the coastal mountain ranges and the sea. This flowing design determines the different levels of the winery and indirectly allows for gentle handling of both the grapes and musts. Their sustainability practices include using chickens and sheep in the vineyards to control pests and weeds and provide natural fertiliser for the vines with their manure.

Roots grow deep and a unique micro climate allows good exposure to sunlight with warm days, cool nights and no rainfall during ripening or harvesting.

# URUGUAY

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Uruguay is located on a similar latitude to Australia, Argentina and South Africa. As with these other wine-producing countries, this geographic situation affords the grapes an abundance of sunshine and warmth. Uruguay is also the only country in South America to produce wines close to the Atlantic Ocean. The Antarctic winds provide cooler coastal temperatures that help maintain the acidity levels in the fruit. The resulting wines are bright and fresh!

## Culture

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Despite its small size, Uruguay has a strong sense of nationalistic culture. The contribution of its alternating conquerors and diverse immigrants has resulted in native traditions that integrate into this diversity. Uruguay has centuries old remains of fortresses from the colonial era. Its cities have a rich architectural heritage and an impressive number of writers, artists, and musicians.

Family gatherings are very important to the Uruguayans. Sunday lunch, Christmas, New Year's, King's Day, and birthdays are all reasons for families to get together to eat, BBQ, drink wine, and share each other's company.

## Terroir

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The region's calcareous and chalk soils are similar to those of Bordeaux, giving the South American wines their darker colours and heavier feel. As a result of these influences, the style is sometimes interpreted as mid-way between New World and Old World.

## Winemaking

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"Uruguay is a country with a big tradition of wine," says Juan Andres Marichal, Vice President of Vinos del Uruguay, a trade association of the country's winemakers. Uruguay's wine immigrants started arriving around 1870, primarily from Italy and Spain. Looking at history, Juan notes that these people enjoyed "a good culture of wine consumption" and, indeed, many of them planted vines and began crafting their own wines.

Most of Uruguay's wine production is from smaller, family-run estates. That generally translates into higher quality fruit and wines made with greater care. In recent years, about twenty Uruguayan wineries began courting international markets with inventive blends and with their signature red 'tannat'.

## Tannat

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Tannat grape vines, originally from the southwest of France, were first planted in Uruguay in 1870 by a Basque immigrant. The vines flourished, yielding a suppler taste than their sometimes astringent (due to high tannin levels) European counterparts. Winemakers talked about developing wines that appeal to global palates (drinkers abroad may find the wine too rustic or earthy).

Tannat is famous for having the highest antioxidant level of any other red wine. Tannat presents a deep, intense colour and complex aromas. The blackberry and raspberry flavours blend well with other notes, often including liquorice and rustic, earthy tones. The good acidity, characteristic tannins and body, make tannat the perfect partner for all kinds of red meat, sausages and dishes with grilled vegetables or mushrooms, and hard cheeses.

# SPAIN

## D.O and D.O.C.a

The Vinos de Denominación de Origen (D.O.) system was founded to ensure the quality of the wine produced in a specific region. Much of the winemaking process is regulated by the D.O., from irrigation to harvest yield to the amount of oak ageing used.

Products labelled “*Denominación de Origen*”, apart from being of superior quality, are expected to carry specific characteristics of a geographical region or individual producer and be derived from raw materials originating within the region. If a region has held D.O. status for at least the previous ten years, producing wine of high quality, following the quality control systems imposed by their regulating body, they may be awarded Denominación de Origen Calificada (D.O.C.a). Rioja was the first Spanish region to be awarded this prestigious status in April 1991, after being the first to receive D.O. status in 1925.

## Ageing

Wines produced in D.O. and D.O.C.a regions may choose to use these common ageing indicators:

**VINO DE CRIANZA:** Term used to describe red wines aged (before release into the market) for a minimum of 24 months, of which 6-12 months (depending on the region) are spent in oak casks with a maximum capacity of 330 litres; white and rosé “Crianza” wines must be aged for at least 18 months with 6 months in oak.

**RESERVA:** Red wines aged for a minimum of 36 months, to include at least 12 months in oak and the rest in the bottle; for white and rosé wines, they must be aged for 18 months, including 6 months on wood.

**GRAN RESERVA:** This distinction is given to red wines aged for a minimum of 60 months, to include at least 18 months in oak; white and rosé wines aged for 48 months, to include 6 months on wood.

## Rioja

Rioja is one of the smallest regions of Spain, but one of the richest in history, culture and nature. Vines have been growing in the fertile valley of the River Ebro since Roman times. It is located south of the Cantabrian Mountains along the Ebro, which create a natural barrier to help isolate the region from the cold wet winds coming from the north and northwest and the fierce winds that the Cantabrian Sea exerts on the Basque provinces.

A distinct characteristic of Rioja wine is the effect of oak ageing. The pronounced vanilla flavour in the wines has been a virtual trademark of the region though some modern winemakers have been experimenting with making wines less influenced by oak.

There are three principal regions of Rioja: Rioja Alta, known for its “old world” style of wines, located on the western edge of the region and at higher elevations than the other areas, produces unripe fruit flavours and a wine that is lighter on the palate; Rioja Alavesa produces wines with a fuller body and higher acidity, despite sharing a similar climate to the Alta region; and Rioja Baja which, unlike the more continental climate of the Alta and Alavesa, is strongly influenced by a Mediterranean climate which makes this area the warmest and driest of the Rioja.

## Ribera del Duero

Ribera del Duero is located on the northern plateau of the Iberian Peninsula. With a unique climate that is a mixture of continental and Mediterranean, Ribera del Duero sees moderate to low rainfall (450 mm per year), dry summers with temperatures of up to 40°C and long harsh winters with temperatures reaching as low as -18°C. These specific weather conditions greatly influence the viticulture and winemaking processes.

Ribera del Duero has a very long history of viticulture and winemaking with the first references to winemaking being found in a 2,000-year-old Roman mosaic discovered in Baños de Valdearados in 1972.

Famous for its bold reds, Ribera del Duero produces aromatic Tinto Fino (Tempranillo) wines that seduce with their intensity and balance. You can expect a top Ribera del Duero to be very well structured, with good body and powerful fruit flavours that are balanced with none-too-subtle woody notes.

## Priorat

The cultivation of vines in the D.O.Q Priorat dates back to 1162 when the Carthusian monks of the Order of Saint Bruno installed themselves, upon request of Alfonso I the Chaste, in the recently recouped region of Siurana. Thus the villages of this area came under the feudal control of the Prior of the Abbey. Since then the region was known as the Priorat.

The D.O.Q. is spread across 1,700 hectares, located south of the Montsant mountain region in the south of Catalonia. Priorat has its own peculiar geological, geographical and meteorological conditions that combine to produce high quality wines with strong personality, where the terroir is always very present. The most typical expressions of this region come from old (Grenache) or Cariñena (Carignan) vines planted on steep slopes of llicorella (schist), giving the wines their characteristic mineral flavours.

## Rias Baixas

Rias Baixas is located in Galicia in north-western Spain. The Rias Baixas D.O. was established in 1988 and is Spain's only exclusively white wine producing D.O. With a lush, cool and damp Atlantic climate, this region is famous for the production of Albariño wines. The area is remarkably similar to the Adelaide Hills region: it is lush and misty, with an abundance of eucalyptus trees.

Albariño is one of the only white Spanish grape varieties produced as a varietal wine on its own. Resistant to fungal diseases, it is a low yielding variety that is difficult to cultivate but highly versatile. It responds well to malolactic fermentation and produces highly complex, aromatic, fresh wine with lots of personality.

## Tempranillo

Indigenous to Spain, Tempranillo is a variety of black grape widely grown to make full-bodied red wines. It is the main grape used in regions like Rioja and Ribera del Duero, and is often referred to as Spain's “noble grape”. Also known under different regional names such as Tinta del País, Tinta Fina and Tinto Fino, Tempranillo is the diminutive of the Spanish temprano (“early”), referring to the fact that it ripens several weeks earlier than most Spanish red grapes.

Tempranillo wines can be consumed young, but the most expensive ones are aged for several years in oak barrels. The wines are ruby red in colour with aromas and flavours of berries, plum, tobacco, vanilla, leather and herb. A highly versatile wine, Tempranillo can be paired with all kinds of meats, rice, vegetables and, of course, tapas.

## Cava

Cava is a Spanish sparkling wine of D.O. status. About 95% of all cava is produced in the Penedès area of Catalonia. The Macabeu, Parellada and Xarel·lo grape varieties are the most popular and traditionally used in the production of Cava. Only wines produced in the *méthode traditionnelle* may be labelled “Cava”. Those produced by other processes may only be called *vinos espumosos* (sparkling wines).

The word “Cava” comes from the Spanish word for “cave”, relating to the historical ageing of cava in caves. In 1970, the name “Cava” was officially adopted by Catalan winemakers to differentiate their product from French Champagne. In the past, Cava was referred to as Spanish Champagne, but this is no longer permitted under European Union law, since “Champagne” has Protected Geographical Status (PGS) and Spain entered the EU in 1986. Cava is now second only to Champagne in world sales of sparkling wine.

Cava is distinctly clean and creamy on the palate and often presents a pastry-like aroma. It is very pleasant to drink by itself or paired with all kinds of food including fish, seafood, poultry, creamy sauces, and desserts.
