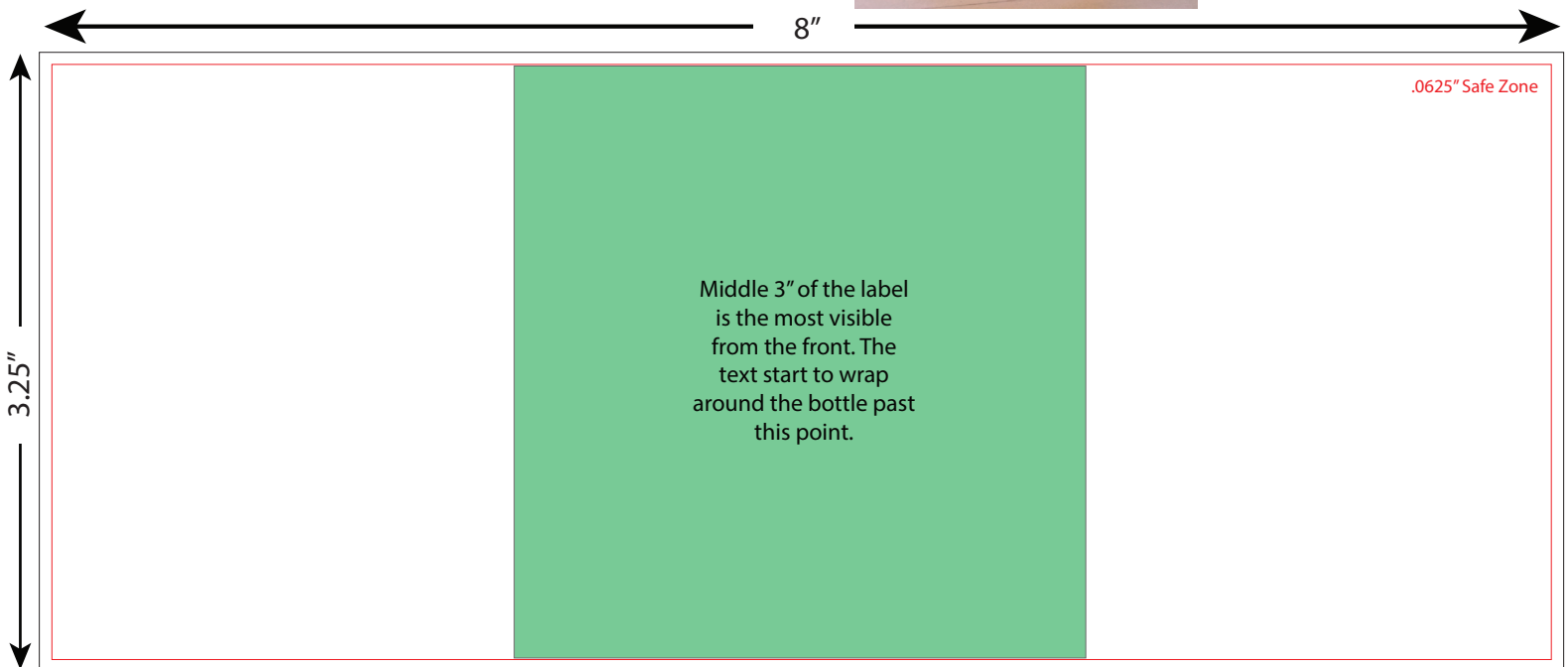


12 fl oz Foaming Hand Soap



The Net Contents needs to have a letter height of .125"
Net Contents Statement needs to be on the Primary Display Panel -The part of a label that the consumer sees or examines when displayed for retail sale. The Net wt will vary depending on what product you put into the Jar.
The term "net weight" or "net wt." Must be used in conjunction with a weight statement, and the term "net contents," "net" or nothing must be used in connection with a liquid statement.

Ingredient Letter Height needs to be .0625" at least.

Warning should always have a letter height of .0625" Good warnings to include:
For external use only, Avoid eye contact. If the product contains Nuts include that into the warning statement

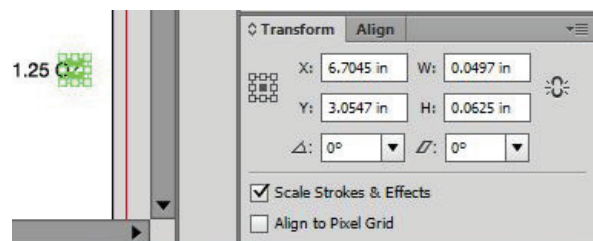
Required Company Information:
"Distributed by" or "Manufactured for"
Company Name
Address (You do not have to use the street part of the address if it is easily found on your Website.)
Web address
Certifier Statement if it is a Certified Product

How do I know what my letter height is?
If you are using UPPERCASE and lowercase or all lowercase letters the letter height is measured by the lowercase "o"
If you are using all UPPERCASE letters measure across the height of the letters.

8 fl. oz. (236 ml)
8 FL. OZ (236ML) $1/8" = .125"$

Safe Zone: The .0625" that you need to stay away from the edge of the label.
If the printer is not perfectly aligned anything outside this line may be cut off.

Suggestion: Using Illustrator I like to use "N" or "Z" because they have very flat tops.
I find the best way to measure the letter height it to copy and paste a copy of the text below the text you are measuring. Then right click and click "Outline Text". Double click on a single letter and use the Transform tab to measure the Height of the letter.
