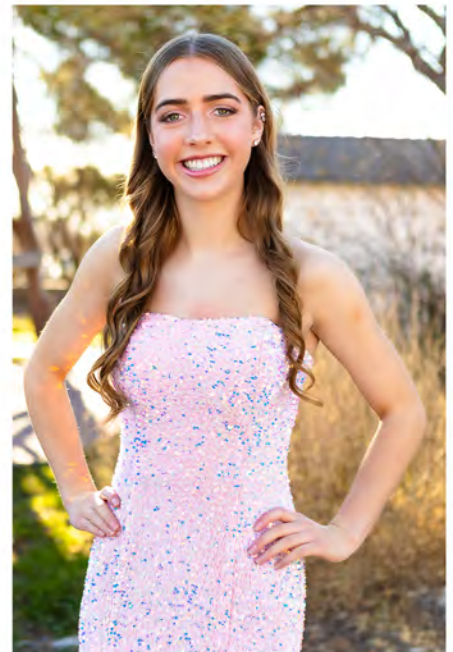
## KEATON RYAN ABSHER

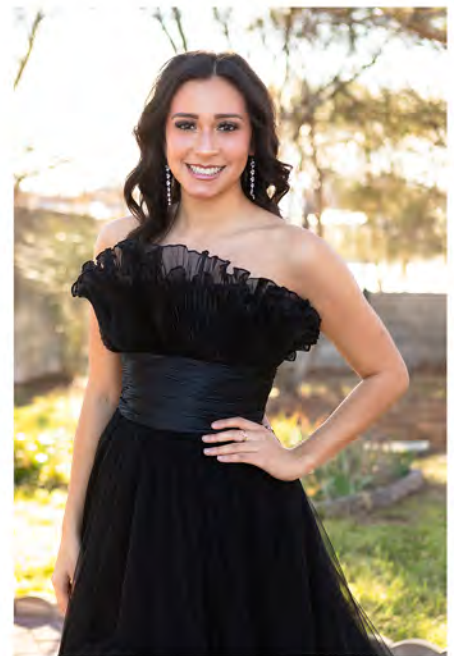
## SIERRA KATE DOBBS

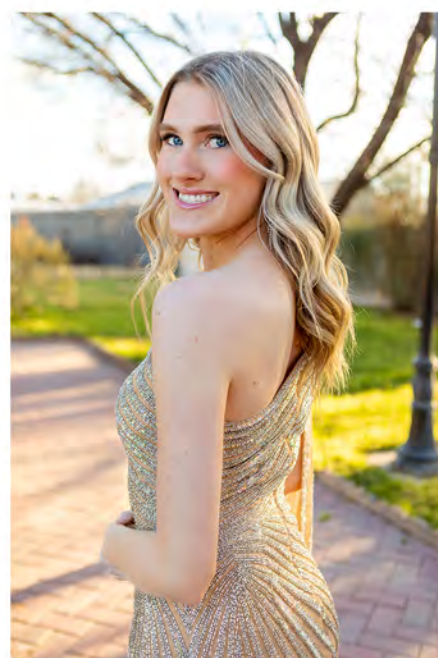
# CARLEIGH SHAE JONES
