1. Turquoise (#00CFB9)

- **RGB:** (0, 207, 185)
- **Explanation:** A vibrant, fresh color often associated with calmness and creativity. It's a bright and engaging color that stands out well.
- **Usage:** Ideal for main highlights, call-to-action buttons, or key elements in designs.

2. Gold (#D4AF37)

- **RGB:** (212, 175, 55)
