

A "**pod**", in relation to people, is a collective noun for **a group of people working together**. The term "pod" implies **a close-knit, cohesive group, often with a sense of unity, cooperation and belonging** and typically displays the following key elements:

1. Shared purpose (entrepreneurial spirit)
2. Diversity and inclusivity
3. Mutual support and collaboration
4. Regular community events (Founder's Fridays, Mentorship Mondays)
5. Celebrating individual successes
6. Shared resources and expertise
7. Emotional connection and empathy

A "**pod**", in relation to buildings, is a modular or **self-contained space** .

A "**whiz kid**" is a colloquialism referring to a person who **achieves remarkable success or accomplishment in a particular field, such as business or entrepreneurship**. The term "whiz kid" conveys admiration and recognition of people who inspire and impress their peers.

2. Creative problem-solving
3. Resilience and adaptability
4. Strong networking skills
5. Visionary thinking

Examples of entrepreneurial whiz kids . . .

1. Steve Jobs (co-founded Apple at 21)
2. Mark Zuckerberg (co-founded Facebook at 19)
3. Richard Branson (started Virgin Records at 22)
