2.2 Navigation Behavior

Header behavior

- **Sticky header** after initial scroll threshold (e.g., after 32–64px)
- Header changes from “transparent over hero” to “solid surface” on scroll on pages with hero sections
- On pages without hero sections, header loads in solid surface state
- Always include one primary CTA in header: “**Continue to OpenReal**” (external)

Dropdown logic
