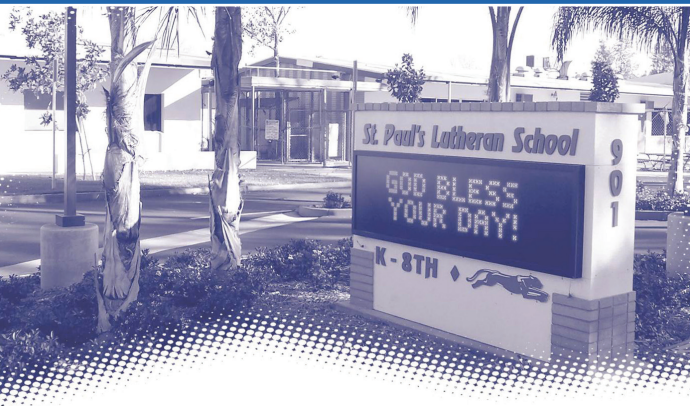
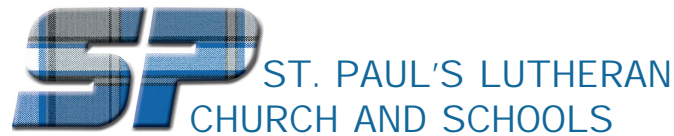


Only Blue Ribbon Lutheran School

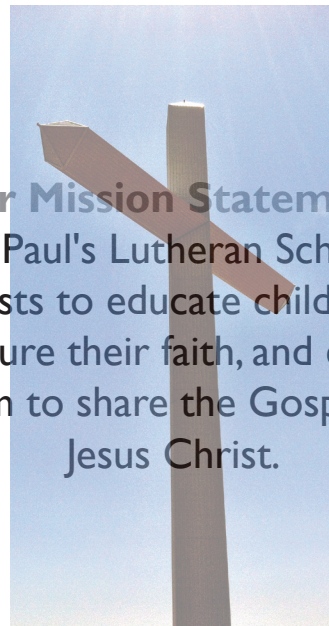
