**What to produce to expect:**

June- (Broccoli, Cabbage, Sugar Snap Peas, Various Lettuces, Spinach, Kale, Swiss Chard, Beets)

July - (Broccoli, Lettuces, Kale, Snow Peas, Summer Squash, Zucchini, Cucumbers, Slicing Tomatoes, Cherry Tomatoes, Green Beans, October Beans, White & Yellow Corn)

August - (Same as July also - Various Bell Peppers, Sweet Peppers, Hot Peppers, Sweet onions)

September/Mid-October (much the same as July/August along with several different varieties of potatoes along with a few surprises :)

**What fruit to expect:**

July/August- (Peaches, Pears, & Blackberries)

September- (Eating & Cooking Apples)

**Free Range Pastured Egg Share:**

1 Dozen Large Brown Eggs weekly for 20 weeks

**\*CSA Member Responsibilities\* - Please Read ☺**

As a CSA member, you share in the bounty as well as the potential risks that may occur on the farm. Being a member enables you to form a relationship with the farmer, the farm and the people that are involved with growing the crops. Becoming a member is a commitment. We ask that if you can't finish the season as members, then you are welcome to reassign your share to another family, but we cannot issue a refund. We also want you to be fully free to share your expectations and feedback on the produce, fruit, and eggs you receive. We will strive to give you the best we have to offer, and make sure you are satisfied with our produce ☺.

If you are unable to pick up your box on delivery day, you must make alternate arrangements for your produce ahead of time.

You can have someone else pick up your box, ask the farm not to make your box that week, or ask your site coordinator to hold the box for a later pick-up. If you forget to pick up your share, it will be donated to a food pantry or a neighborhood family. **KINDLY READ ANY EMAILS THAT WE SEND OUT TO YOU!** This is how we communicate with you with announcements, recipes, events and special offers!
