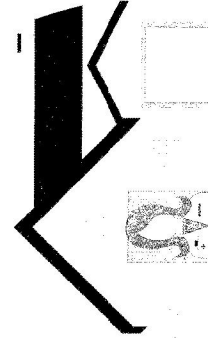
DATA CENTERS

Data centers give hospitals a secure environment for storage, application production and off-premise work flows. Comcast Business has extended its fiber network into several hundred data centers across the U.S.



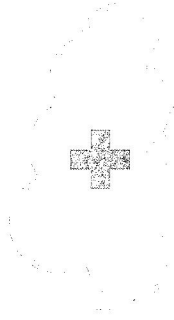

(Point to Multipoint)

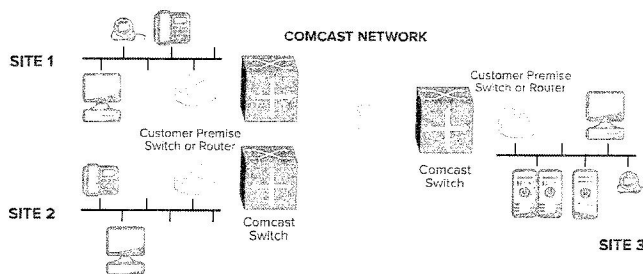

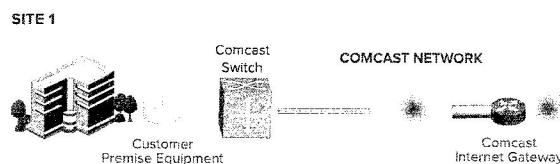
