Vineyard Region

This wine is sourced from premium wine regions across South Eastern Australia.

Vintage Conditions

Fruit for this wine was sourced from selected vineyards in South Eastern Australia. The 2009 vintage was characterised by excellent rains in December, elevated temperatures in February prior to veraison, followed by ideal cool to mild temperatures leading to an ideal harvest in March.

This wine was matured in stainless steel to maintain varietal purity.

Colour

Pale straw with a slight blush.

Nose

The nose is fresh, lively and intensely aromatic with crisp aromas of nashi pear, pink grapefruit and pomegranate.

Palate

A long, lingering and luscious palate with concentrated flavours of red apple, pear and fleshy pomegranate. Delicious, crisp and delicate with ripe summer fruit flavours. The wine is full flavoured with a soft and lively finish.
