Vintage Conditions

The fruit for this wine was sourced from selected vineyards in South Eastern Australia. The 2010 vintage was characterised by excellent rains in December, elevated temperatures in January prior to veraison followed by ideal cool conditions leading to an ideal harvest in February and March.

Maturation

A small parcel of this wine was briefly matured with French oak for three months while the majority remained unoaked to retain a fresh fruit focus.

Colour

Vibrant cherry red with purple hues.

Nose

The nose shows ripe, spicy aromas with touches of cherry and strawberry.

Palate

Rosemount Diamond Label Pinot Noir is a medium bodied wine with flavours of cherry, strawberry and subtle spicy tones. The soft round palate finishes with velvety tannins.
