What is CPE?

- ▶ Continuing & Professional Education (CPE) at University of Colorado Denver's School of Education & Human Development (SEHD) supports the ongoing professional education of school teachers, administrators, and mental health professionals by offering programs to individuals, schools, and districts.
- ▶ We are dedicated to improving student learning while fostering student opportunity by increasing the number of powerful school teachers and education leaders. CPE partners with community organizations to offer professional development that is what you need when you need it.
- ▶ CPE offers a wide range of courses and programs that are tailored to area partners and are available in varying lengths and types of credit.
 - Continuing education units (for relicensure)
 - Graduate certificates
 - Master's degrees, and
 - Courses that lead to a Doctor of Education (EdD) degree.
- ▶ Depending on the program, our credit satisfies district and Colorado Department of Education (CDE) requirements for relicensure, salary increase, and/or career advancement as well as CDE endorsements and university degree programs.
- ▶ Some courses are developed in cooperation with school districts and community agencies to meet the specific education and training needs of partner organizations. Other courses articulate with SEHD's regular master's programs; entire master's degree and endorsement programs are also available. Courses are off-campus in locations selected for their convenience to students, and can be delivered online or in-person.
