Hearing is connected to movement in the brain, when the proper movement is provided, the ears then open up to sounds and hearing. Movement is what OT's are skilled in providing.

Therapies provided include movement, auditory processing, and visual processing techniques. Other techniques such as reflex integration may be incorporated.

Auditory Processing

Most children with some form of AP delays, display difficulties with;

Processing information that they hear and/or

Remembering information that they hear.

This affects children's learning, especially in the younger grades where information they hear must be remembered and understood properly. Such as remembering names of individuals in parsha or even classmates names.

Visual Processing

Children with VPD have difficulty with;

Processing information that they see and/or

Remembering information that they see.

These children will have difficulty remembering and/or understanding information that they need to see.

In the younger grades it's learning ABC. Letters are a geometric shape that children have to remember the visual differences of and remember its name/sound. Later on it is understanding and remembering notes for a test.



Combining visual and Auditory information

Children can display difficulty combining the auditory information to a visual object and vis versa.

Such as applying the name of a letter to the actual letter, they may remember the name and how the letter looks but they do not remember which letter it applies to. This is the same, but more advanced in the older years.

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Many children with visual processing delays can explain you all the information before the test and not do well on the actual exam, because exams are visual.
