Why would you do this to yourself?

Where do you think your heat will go during winter? That's right, straight out your windows. That is unless you put up heavy drapes or blinds. How is that view working for you now? Some people do it half-heartedly and insulate one side. Would you only put batts in one side of your house? No? Well why are you even considering only one side being insulated with your windows and doors? The secret to your comfortable home.... Lean in.... is to seal your whole building envelope. This way that tricky heating won't find a way to escape. We can also not describe to you the amazing comfort you will feel without draughts and condensation. Double glazing is an insulator and just as important as your batts. The heat in winter comes through your windows as a long ray and converts to a short ray. Your heating inside is a short ray. The double glaze unit stops the short ray escaping through the glass.
