Consul General Vuong Hai Nam was born on September 4th, 1962 in Bac Ninh Province, Vietnam. He began his most recent tenure as Consul General of Viet Nam in San Francisco in September 2014. Prior to his post to San Francisco, he was Director General of the Department of South East Asia-South Asia-South Pacific, Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

Consul General Vuong is a career diplomat. He joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 1985. He was posted

as Third Secretary at the Embassy of Vietnam in Lao People's Democratic Republic during 1991-1994. He served as Minister Counselor at the Embassy of Vietnam in the Kingdom of Cambodia from 2000 to 2003. During 2007 - 2011, he was Vietnam's Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to New Zealand.

Consul General Vuong earned his B.A. at the College of Foreign Affairs and his M.A. at the Diplomacy Academy of Vietnam. He is fluent in Vietnamese, English and French. He is married with one son and one daughter.
