New Bohemia is the next generation of sausage house and beer hall. This new fast casual restaurant combines great sausages, creative toppings, hand cut Belgian fries with chef created dipping sauces with an amazing selection of national, regional and local craft beers, all in a cool hip environment with contemporary background music spun by a DJ as the hall transforms from day to night.

Why...

The concept leverages the popularity and energy of Irish, Belgian and German pubs with a fast casual service format. The broad beer selection is designed to take advantage of the growing popularity of craft and specialty beers. According to a National Restaurant Association survey, even women, about half of them are ordering microbrews when eating out. While other segments of US beverage consumption have been flat, craft beer sales increased 12% in 2011.

New Bohemia is poised to penetrate this expanding market with a new spin on the beer hall blending a hip new vibe with old world traditions.

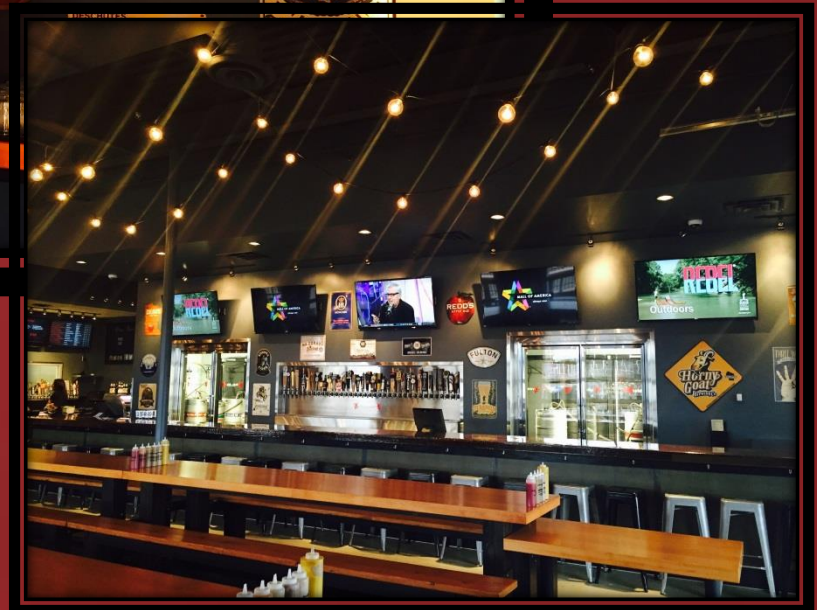
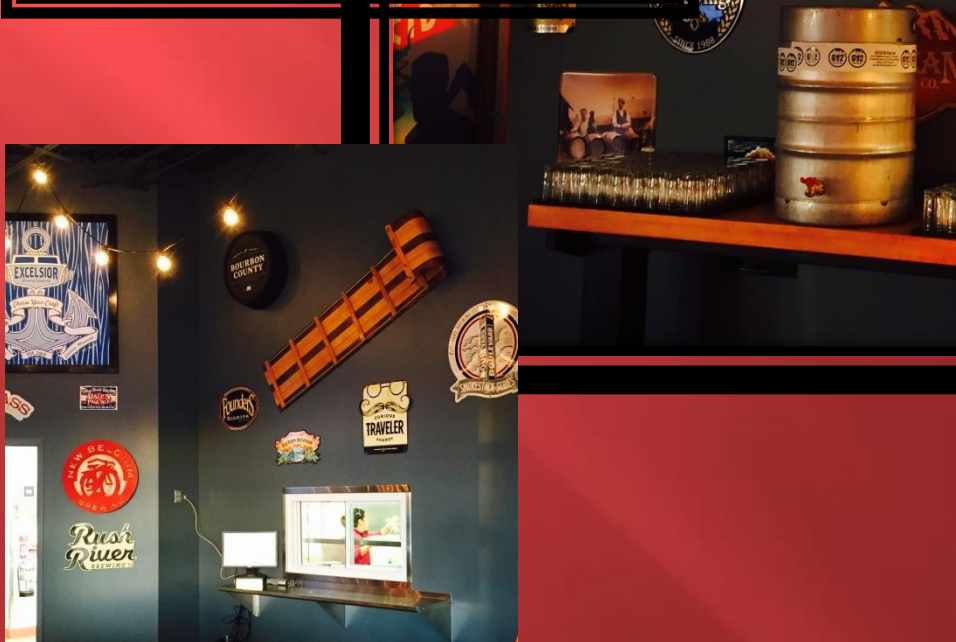

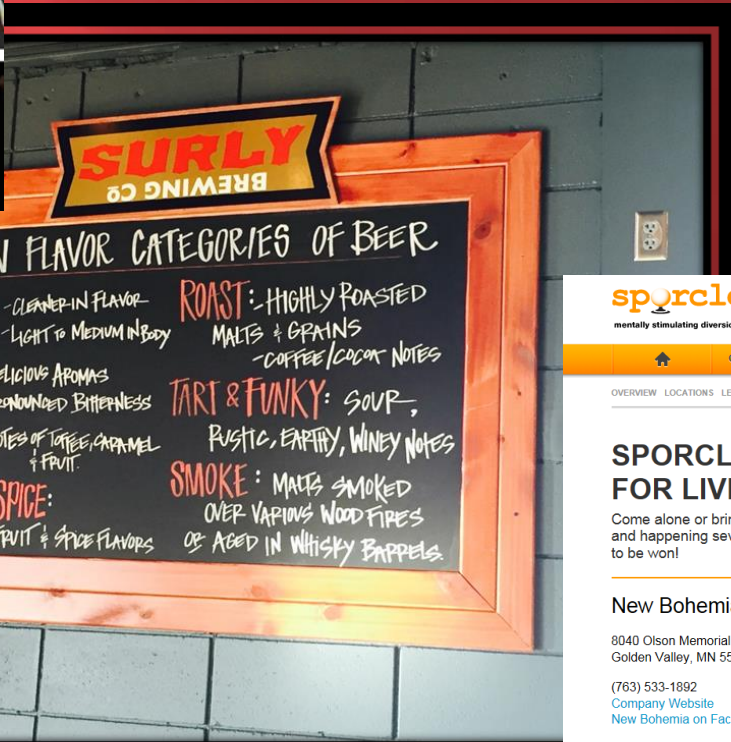

New Bohemia Wurst + Bierhaus (Golden Valley, MN)

Without any planning of my own, I followed beery freinds to [New Bohemia Wurst + Bierhaus](#) in Golden Valley after the latest One Voice concert. Being a vegetarian, a bratwurst specialty pub hasn't inspired me to stop for a pint. Serious mistake. Upon walking in, friends had already filled a long, sociable table and promptly asked me to try the pretzel with pepperjack cheese sauce: light, delicious and massive.

Overwhelmed by beer choices, it took time to pick a new beer to insure New Bohemia on my database. I settled on Lucid Duce, a more than satisfactory amber ale for the end of an evening. A well curated tap list, New Bohemia had a serious devotion to Minnesota with about half of the taps dedicated to local brews. The remainder had some very good national and regional brews. I settled on New Belgium La Folie for a second draft

Spears and a Giant Pretzel with Pepperjack Cheese Sauce. When they say giant, they mean giant. For \$14 you can enjoy the most expensive item on the menu, a 13-inch pretzel that feeds four.

Another big hit on the menu includes Belgian-Style Fries. Chose one of 10 homemade dipping sauces which includes Bacon Blue Cheese, Wasabi Ginger Mayo, Honey Mustard and Stout Beer Barbecue Sauce in name a few.

"We put a lot of heart, soul and thought into this menu," Bornmann said.

Bornmann said his current favorite combo is a Smoked Jalapeno and Cheese Sausage topped with Sweet and Hot Peppers and Spicy Kraut paired with a Bent Paddle Cold Press (ale).

For less adventurous little eaters, mini corn dogs and beef hot dogs are available.

Now that you've consumed your first beverage, scan the list again for a new favorite.

From Bent Paddle and Four Daughters to Lift Bridge and Surly, New Bohemia boasts an ever-changing list of craft beers

as well as regional options.

If you're out with a crowd of similar beer drinkers, splurge for a growler. But note it must be consumed on-site.

Not a beer drinker? Rootbeer is available on tap or try a white or red wine from St. Croix Vineyard.

Golden Valley's New Bohemia is not the first for this local small company. It also has operated for three years in Northeast Minneapolis.

The idea for New Bohemia came from understanding the current popular trends in dining. Burger

joins and craft taprooms are popular, at least in the Midwest.

"Not wanting to offer burgers since they were not flexible enough for creativity, the owners asked themselves, 'What goes really well with beer?'"

Sausage.

"You can do a lot of things with a sausage," Bornmann said.

Desiring to know more about this style of restaurant operations, the owners traveled the country visiting similar establishments to learn what works and what does not.

Then came the difficult

task of naming the establishment.

"What we really tried to create was a reinvention of the beer hall," Bornmann said.

When he thinks of beer halls, Bornmann first thinks of Bavaria or Bohemia.

"We consider ourselves the new Bohemia," Bornmann said. "We have a beer hall feel but it's a reinvention of that with craft beer."

After receiving positive feedback and increasing business at its Minneapolis location, the owners chose to place another location in Golden Valley.

So far residents' reactions have been great, according to Bornmann.

"We've been really blown away by the neighborhood response," he said.

New Bohemia hosts happy hour 3-6 p.m. and 10 p.m. to close every day. Roughly six tap beers will be offered for \$3 and the happy hour options will rotate.

In addition to daily specials, certain days boast extra perks.
