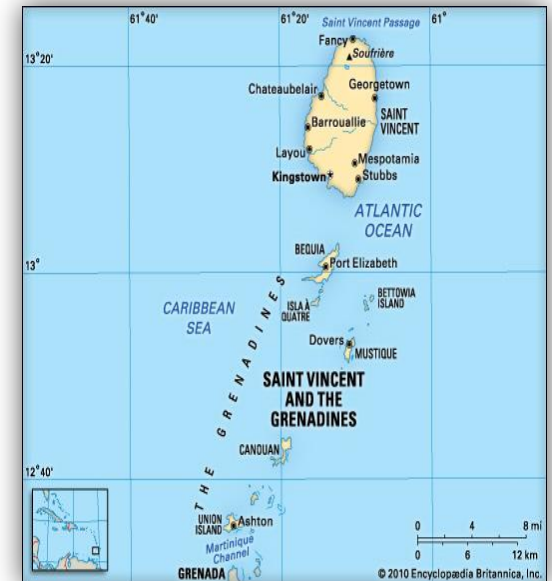
#### **Mustique**
