Pre-K Curriculum

All of our Pre-K programs emphasize our Catholic faith through daily prayer, Bible stories, and learning to be more like Jesus. They follow a curriculum that covers language, mathematics, science, social studies, religion, handwriting, fine and gross motor skills, and music. All programs incorporate individual, small group, and large group work through hands-on activities. All programs encourage not only the academic development of the children, but the social and emotional development as well.



Traditional Preschool

3 year old program
(children must be three years old
and toilet-trained by September 1)

This program provides experiences to help children begin to learn and work with others in a group setting, to explore materials, to develop language and motor skills through play. Children in the full day program will be offered various enrichment activities throughout the afternoon.

- Tuesdays and Thursdays
- ½ Day: 8am-11am
- Full Day: 8am-3pm

Traditional Preschool

4 year old program
(children must be four years old
and toilet-trained by September 1)

This program provides opportunities for children to work individually, in small groups, and as a large group. Activities are provided through play centers focused on expanding language, increasing fine and large motor skills, acquiring concepts (colors, shapes, numbers, letters, etc.), and learning how to cooperate and interact with others. Children in the full day program will be offered various enrichment activities throughout the afternoon.

- Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays
- ½ Day: 8am-11am
- Full Day: 8am-3pm

Montessori Preschool

Multi-Age program
(children must be three years old
and toilet-trained by September 1)

The program is composed of a mixed age group between 3 & 5 years. The Montessori philosophy guides the children in all academic areas of the classroom. We believe that children are unique and learn at their own pace. Children will have an individualized learning plan put in place by the teacher to meet their learning style. This will set the foundation for a lifetime of learning. Materials and activities are available to meet the individual and developmental needs of a mixed age group of children. 3 year olds may choose three or five ½ days or three or five full days

- 4 and 5 year olds may choose five ½ days or five full days
- ½ Day: 8am-11am
- Full Day: 8am-3pm



Young Fives

5 year old program
(children must be five years old
by December 31)

This program provides opportunities for children who need additional time for development and maturity before entering Kindergarten. It also provides an opportunity for those children with fall birthdays, who miss the Kindergarten cut off, to have more than a preschool experience. Short, structured lessons are taught from a formal curriculum and hands-on work experiences are provided to best meet the needs of the children.

- Mondays through Fridays
- ½ Day: 8am-11am
- Full Day: 8am-3pm
