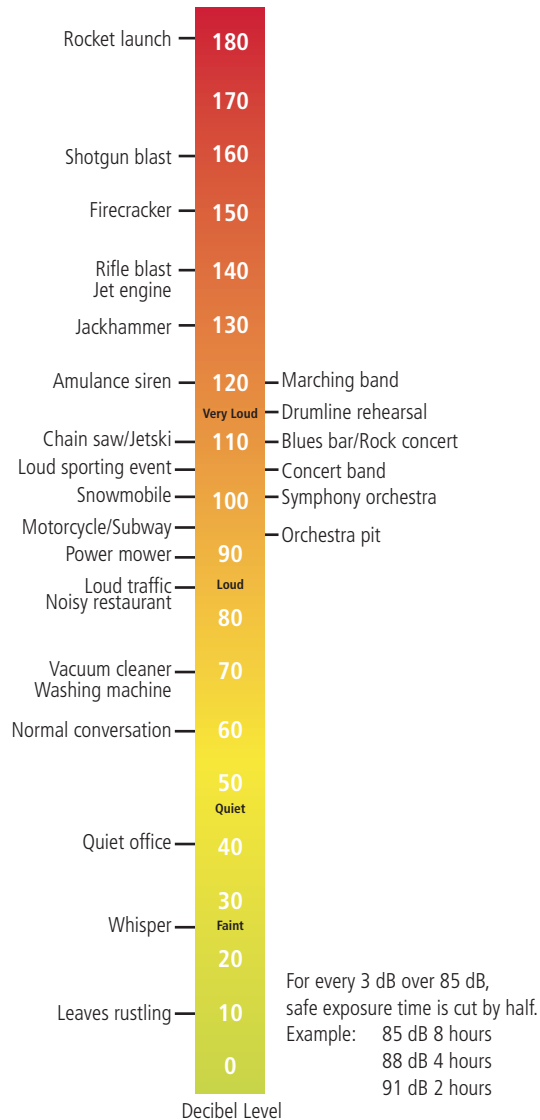

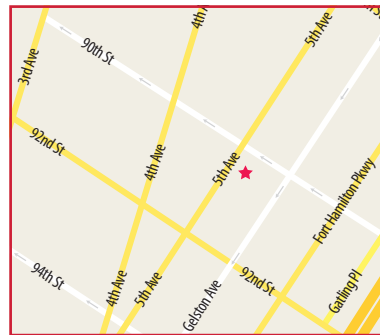
Time to reach daily exposure limit

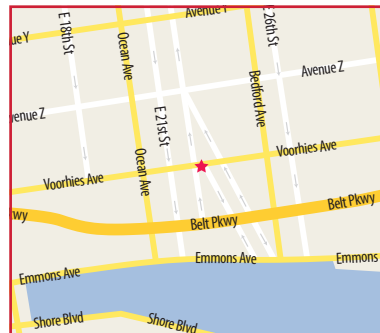

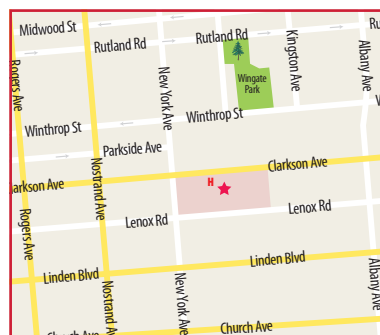

## HEARING LOSS IS A COMMON CONDITION

More than 34 million Americans have some type of hearing disorder. Fewer than 9 million receive appropriate care. Hearing disorders are often unrecognized by the patient. Children and teenagers seldom complain about the symptoms of hearing loss, and adults may lose their hearing so gradually they do not realize it is happening. Approximately 90 million Americans seek treatment for a balance problem at least once in their lifetime. It is the second most common complaint people discuss with their doctors.

Doctors of Audiology assist in the patient treatment of hearing and balance disorders by combining a complete history with a variety of specialized auditory and vestibular assessments. Based upon the information reported to the physician, the audiologist presents a variety of treatment options to the patient. For hearing problems, treatment can include hearing aids, assistive listening devices, cochlear implants, and audiologic rehabilitation.

As Allied health care providers concerned with hearing and balance, audiologists are educated to recognize these medical problems and assist the physician in managing these patients. They consult with physicians, surgeons, optometrists, educators, and psychologists to help patients receive the highest level of care.
