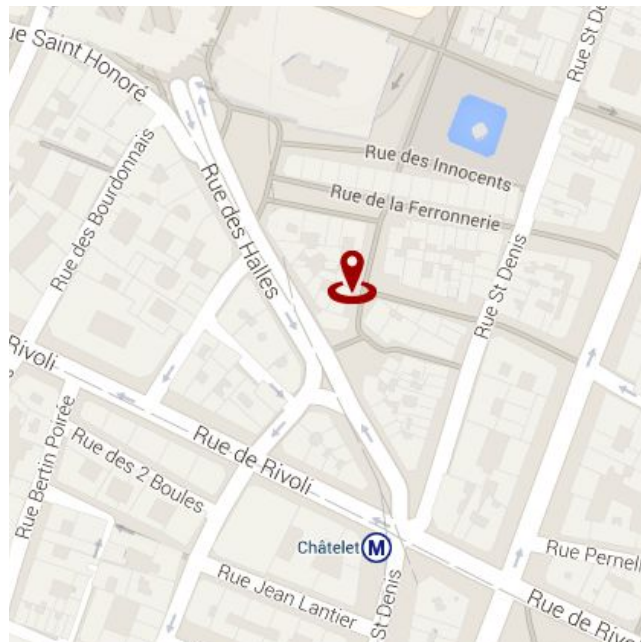

How to use the metro:

You have each been given 3 Metro tickets to help you on your way. Although you may need additional tickets depending on what your plans are in your free time. They are €4 for a single journey. Once you're in the Metro station, how to use the tickets is pretty self explanatory. Tip from Roxane- the tickets have a magnetic strip so try and keep them away

from bank cards etc. If you find that any of your tickets do not work, you can ask at the kiosk for a replacement.
