

General Health

General medical care in Dubai is reasonably very good, with clinics for general and specialized care widely available. There is a ambulance system but this is mainly for transportation rather than treatment, but the hospitals are well-equipped to deal with most emergencies.

The water is safe to drink in the UAE, although most people prefer to buy bottled water for its taste. The food is clean and in the majority of situations is served to western standards, however hygiene can be an issue on some roadside stalls out of the city.

Vaccines

Depending on your itinerary, your personal risk factors, and the length of stay, your health care provider may offer you vaccination against Hepatitis A & B, influenza, rabies or Typhoid. Routine immunizations, such as those that prevent Tetanus/ Diphtheria or 'childhood' diseases, should be reviewed and updated as needed.

Other Concerns

Food and water-borne diseases including Hepatitis A and Typhoid fever are transmitted by unsanitary food handling procedures and contaminated water. Travellers should carry medication and/or an antibiotic for presumptive self-treatment of diarrhea if it occurs.

Take note that some prescriptions or over the counter medicines purchased in other countries are illegal in UAE. Codeine, for example, is banned in the UAE and no products containing codeine can be imported or sold in the country. In contract, antibiotics are freely available over the counter at pharmacies.

Personal Safety

The crime rate is virtually zero in Dubai, and the Dubai Police has highly efficient law enforcement and emergency procedures in place. Law enforcement officers are also generally speak English, are courteous and helpful to visitors and residents alike.

Cars are the main method of transportation around Dubai and the majority of major hotels provide luxury cars, and or shuttle bus services for guest to major destinations.

Dubai has an extensive taxi system, a comprehensive bus network, an automated Metro system and convenient waterways that connect you from the airport to anywhere in the city.

Taxis




Taxis are the most common way of getting around. Metered cabs from Dubai Transport Corporation, recognised by their cream colour, are efficient and have well-trained and courteous drivers.

Taxis are all officially regulated by the RTA (Roads & Transport Authority) marked with meters and most drivers speak basic English. Avoid shared or service taxis.

The Taxis are all predominately beige in colour are cheap, safe and can be hailed down everywhere. Dubai does not operate on addresses. Everything is located in relationship to major landmarks (i.e. opposite the Emirates Towers).

Metro




Opened in September 2009, Dubai's Metro, operates automated trains that run at ten-minute intervals, between ten stations located across the city. Current rules allow commuters to carry up to two pieces of luggage (with one being hand luggage).

- Thursday 5:50am to 01:00am
- Friday 1:00pm to 01:00am
- Saturday 5:50am to 00:00pm

The RTA operates a good public bus service from 6:00am-11:00pm that serves most corridors of the city. Public Bus system (<http://www.rta.ae>).


Ferry's



The Water Taxi service, the first of its kind in the region, covers public marine transport stations and berths of some hotels, tourist resorts and marine clubs in Dubai including the Dubai Creek area, Al Mamzar Corniche, Jumeirah Open Beach and Dubai Marina through to Jebel Ali, linking coastal hotels with historical areas like Al Fahidi, Al Shindagha and the Old Souk.
