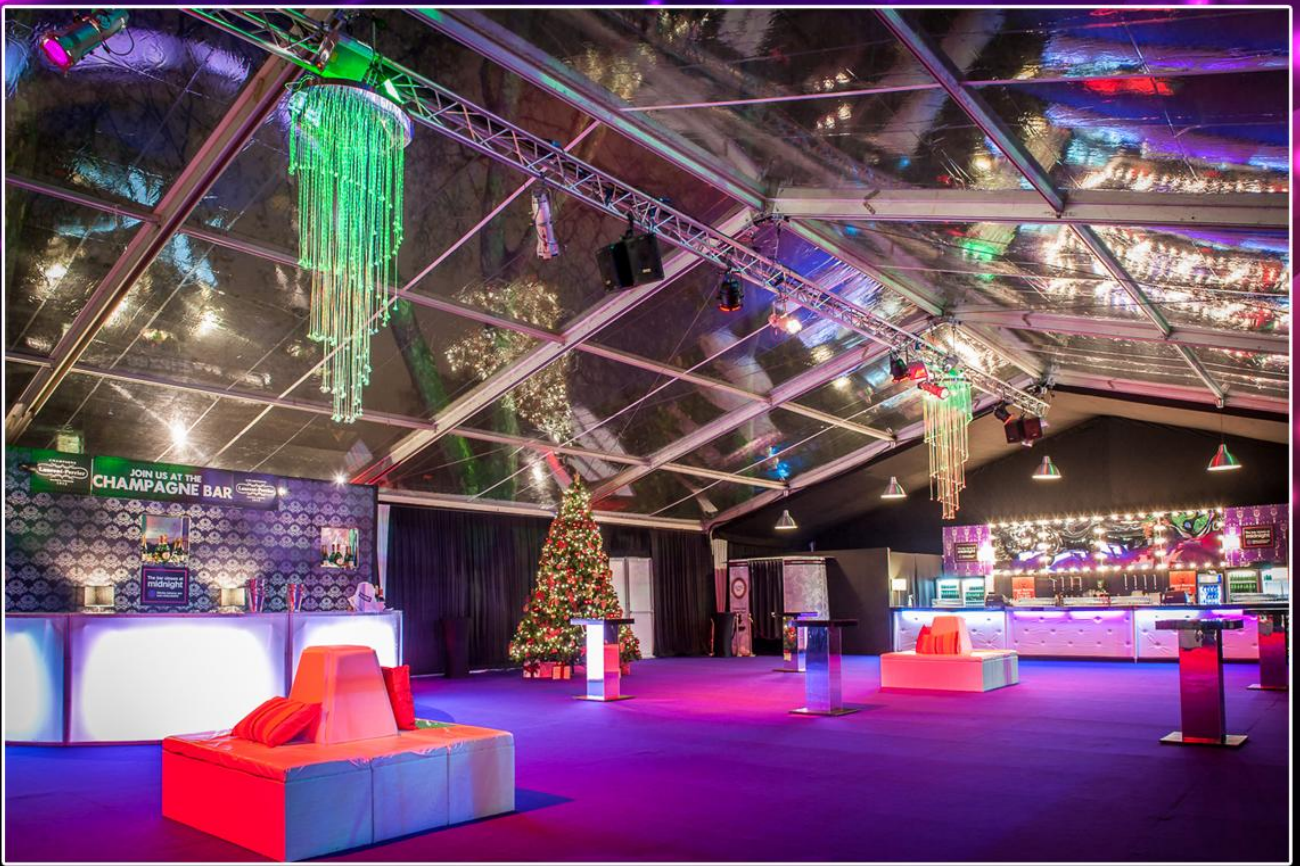

The reception area comprises of two large cloakrooms, luxury toilet facilities, main feature bar and satellite bar plus occasional furniture

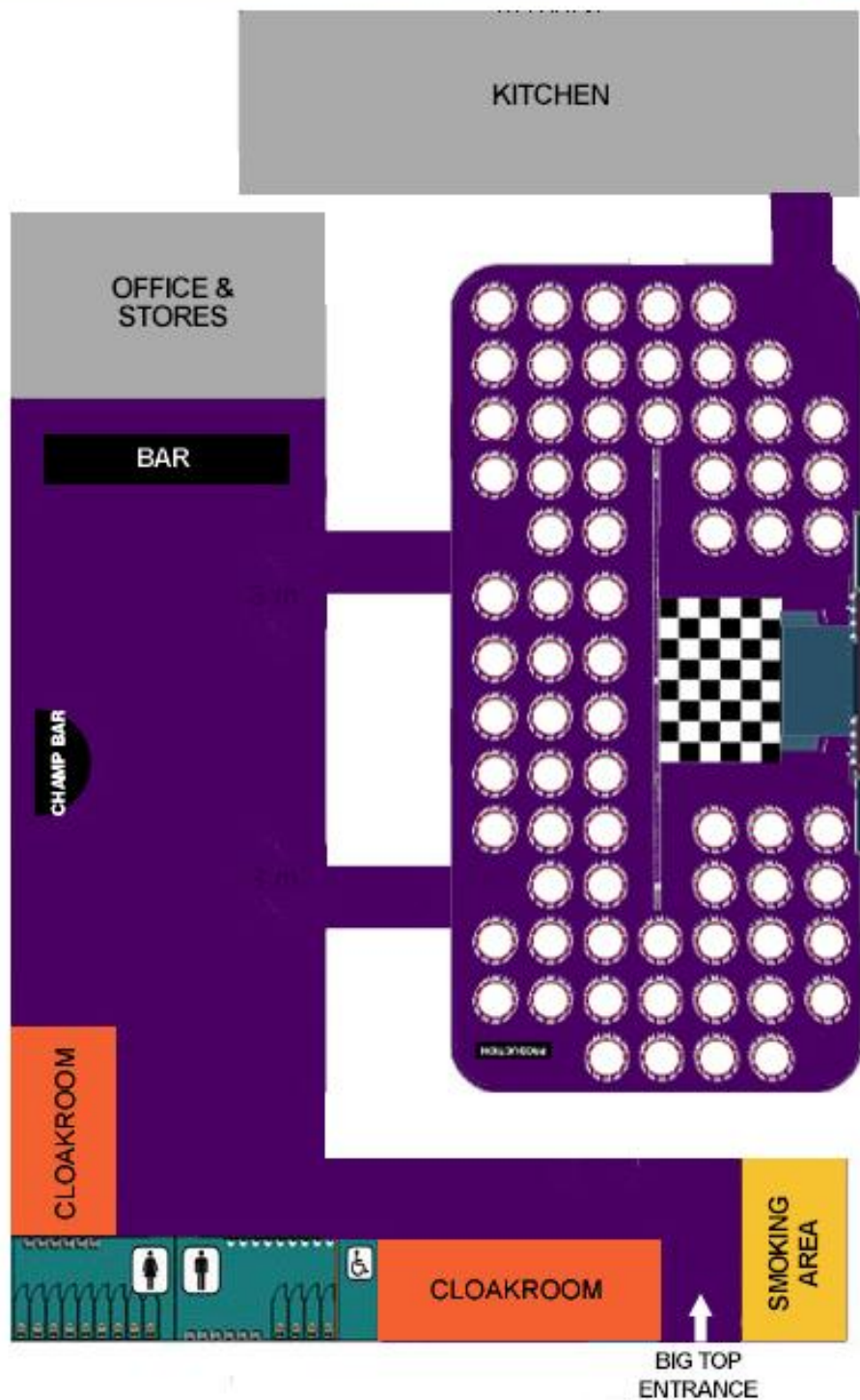
Seated Dinner	up to 750 guests

The Big Top has a state of the art catering marquee attached to the main tent, to guarantee the highest quality produce at all times, as well as thermostatic heating to ensure optimal room temperature.



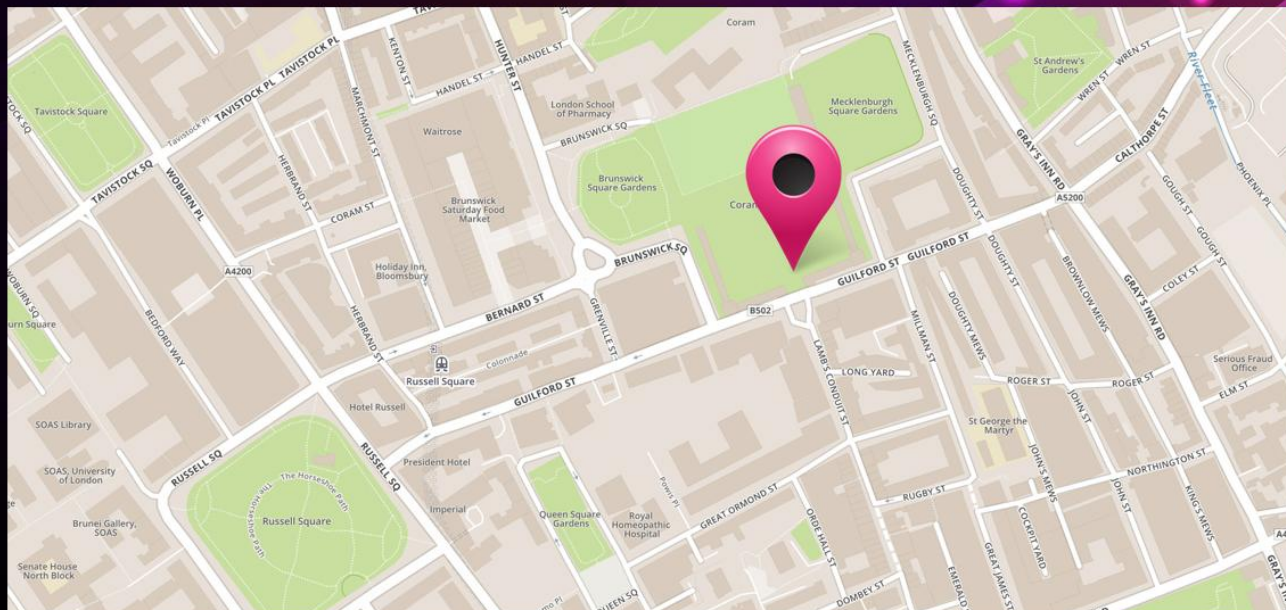
FLOORPLAN
