

CCF Deer Head Antlers, Shape and Texture

Antler shape: On the left side, please use your own judgement to correct the front tine that is crooked and sharply bends in. You may need to slightly adjust the entire side so that it doesn't look off.

Also, if you choose to trace the tines, please smooth them out.



EARS, FACE AND NECK: THE DRAWING OF THIS STOCK PHOTO IS OBVIOUSLY VERY ROUGH AND NEEDS TO BE CLEANED UP. HOWEVER, I LOVE THE OUTLINE SHAPE OF IT. WITHIN THE OUTLINE OF THE HEAD, YOU CAN EITHER DO A SILHOUETTE STYLE OR A FACE DRAWING VERY SIMILAR IN STYLE TO THIS DEER:



FOR TEXTURE, I LIKE THE IDEA OF A SLIGHT CRYSTAL LOOK WITH GEOMETRIC TRIANGLES AS DONE IN THIS EXAMPLE WITH THE ANTLERS BEING A SOLID COLOR AND THEN GRADUALLY GETTING LIGHTER.
