

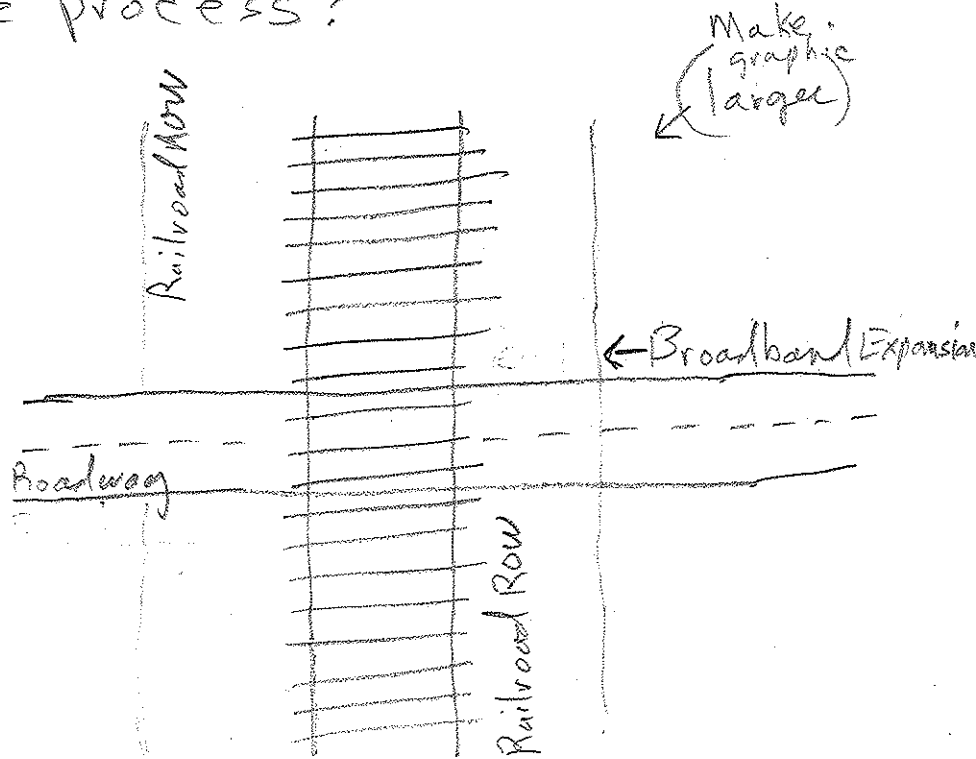
# Crossing Railroad Right of Way (ROW)

"What is the process?"

## PROCESS:

- 1) Contact railroad to obtain application and specifications.
- 2) Submit application to railroad with engineering plans.
- 3) When plans are approved, enter into license agreement with railroad.
- 4) With railroad safety protocols and approved work plan in place, coordinate with operations to obtain flagman.
