

Understanding the Ministry of the Apostle seeks to unpack the nature of true biblical apostles and re-introduce their role in present day ministry. Throughout this book you will learn what apostles do, what working along side one looks like, and how they function within the Ekklesia. In most of the Western church at large the workmanship of an apostle has been reduced to a poor caricature of their true calling. Meaning the few examples of apostolic ministry Christians are exposed to, generally do not resemble a biblical model of a servant-leader, but rather one that is front-loaded with triumphalism, pomp and servitude.

The foundations of this book are grounded in the fivefold ministries Paul outlines in Ephesians 4. It is all the offices working together in unison that makes for eternally effective, biblically sound ministry. While most churches organize themselves around the pastors and teachers, they do not realize those offices were not designed to be the foundation upon which ministry is built. By understanding the ministry of the apostle and furthermore, reintroducing the role among the church, many of the ministerial challenges leaders are facing will naturally resolve themselves.
