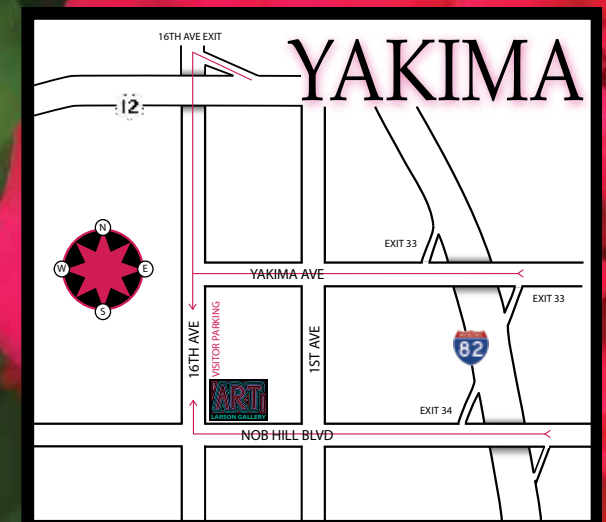
**Become a member of the Larson Gallery Guild**
