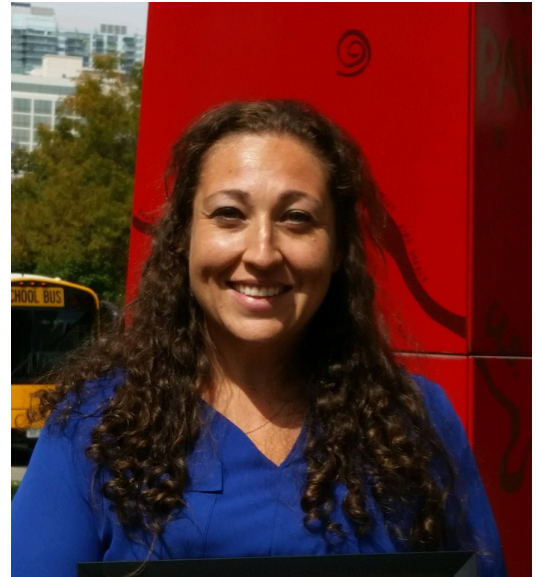


CIANI SOSA, FNP (CO-FOUNDER)
