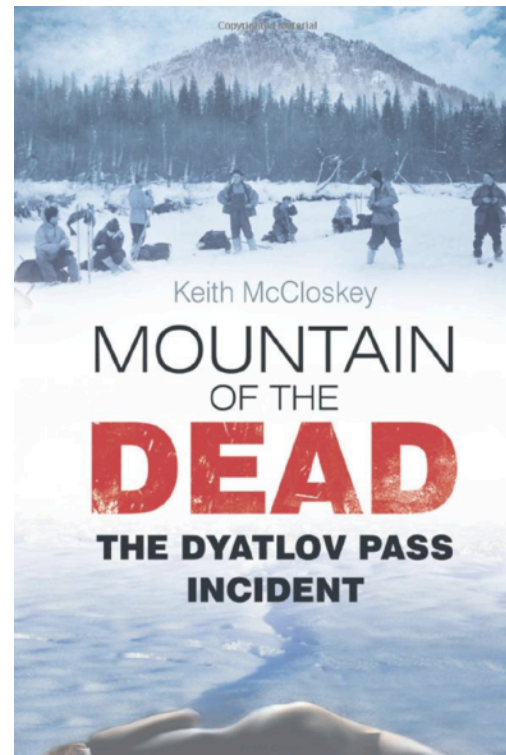
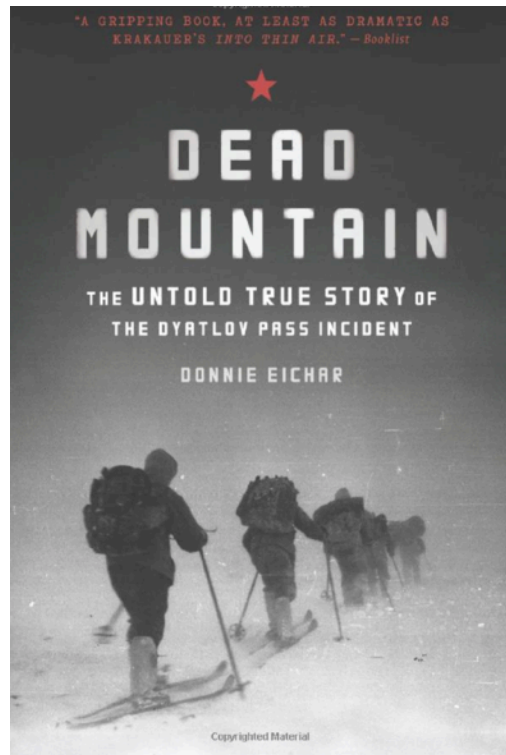


Project Brief:

“Dead Mountain” by Donnie Eichar is my **favorite** by far. I like this a lot but I don’t want to copy it.

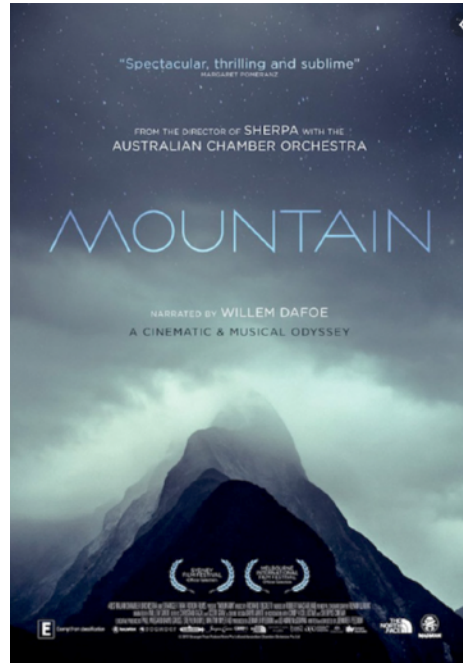
The following three I **DON’T like** very much, but wanted to show you examples of what already exists.

I love the blue green colors in this as well as the "foggy" clouds.

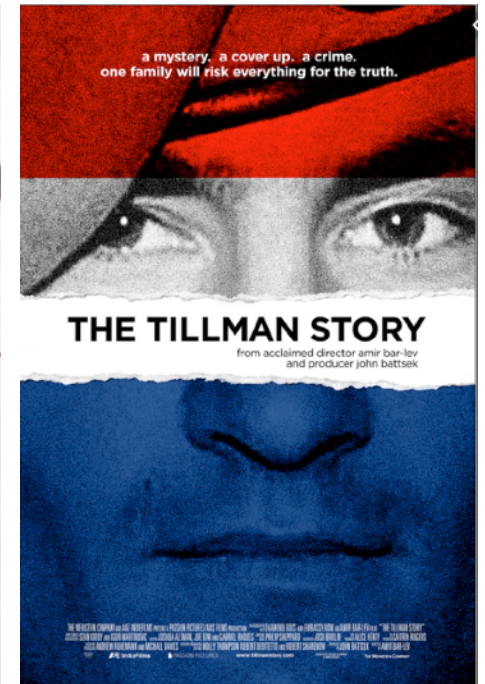
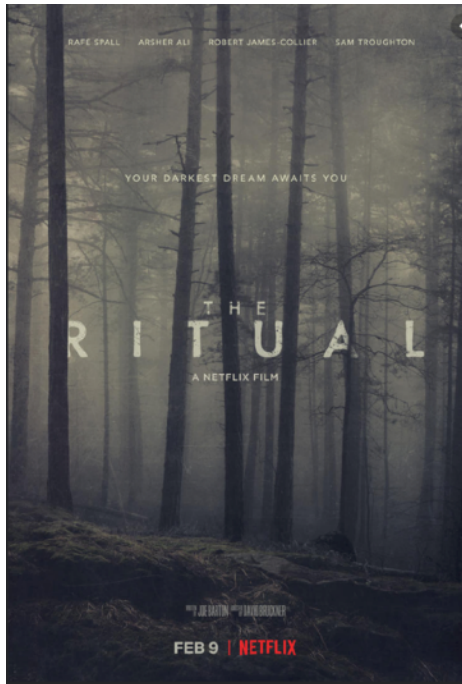


I love the use of photo frame in this one showing other pictures.
