Have a great time exploring downtown! While our downtown foot print may be small, it is mighty - offering a broad range of shopping, services, arts and cuisine all within a few blocks of each other. You can also regularly find fun events taking over our downtown, such as the monthly Sip + Shop and Art Walk, or the seasonal Tillamook Farmers Market.

For early visitors, grab a cup of coffee and a scone from Sarasotas, or if you're in the mood for a full breakfast give the Dutch Mill Diner or the Rendezvous Bar & Grill a try. Downtown is also wide open for lunch or dinner. From Thai or BBQ at the Flavors on First, to Sushi at Tora, flavorful Mexican dishes at La Mexicana, coast-to-table cuisine at Pacific Restaurant and Burgers and Beer at Pelican Brewing, Rodeo Steakhouse, or Kitty's Food & Spirits. Afterwards, fill up on frozen yogurt at Yo Time!

Also located within our downtown is the historic Tillamook Colliseum Movie Theater, the Tillamook County Pioneer Museum and the Art Accelerated Gallery.



Second Street


