DURING WWII AND HER WORLD IS CHANGED
FOREVER.

MOVING THROUGH THE 20TH CENTURY, THIS LIFE
AND THE NEXT, THE AQUARIUM INTERWEAVES
GRIEF, LOSS, THE AFTER-LIFE, MENTAL ILLNESS,
AND ULTIMATELY THE TRUE NATURE OF LOVE.

The Aquarium is a collection of poems documenting the lives of an elderly couple throughout the 20th century. Told in two parts we first meet Charles – aged, crippled and left alone in his inherited Marsh House – reflecting on his life and his marriage to beautiful Alice who we meet in part two. Alice is suicidal, manically depressed and struggling with mental illness and life as a wife and mother. She meets, harbors and falls in love with a soldier during WWII and her world is changed forever. Moving through decades, through the 20th and the next – The Aquarium interweaves stories of grief, loss, the after life, mental illness, and ultimately the true nature of love.
