If you aren't doing this on the server side, then it is likely a waste of time.

The best java script system I've found so far is fairly trivial to bypass or crack. A determined individual can crack HTML based login systems in less than a day and that is the best system I've seen. Simple systems would be cracked in a matter of minutes or perhaps seconds by reading the HTML code and the associated script.


If you want a secure server, then you'll have to go the whole route and deal with making a secure website. Look for a free secure forums system and see how they do it.
