This is the first page a new user sees, and it's implemented as a carousel.

Page 1 requests they supply their email address and choose a password

Enter a memorable name. This creates a URL that belongs to you and can be used to send files to your device

On the second carousel screen the choose a memorable / nickname. This will be the basis of their personal upload URL



Here the user enters a 4 digit PIN that will protect their permanent upload area.

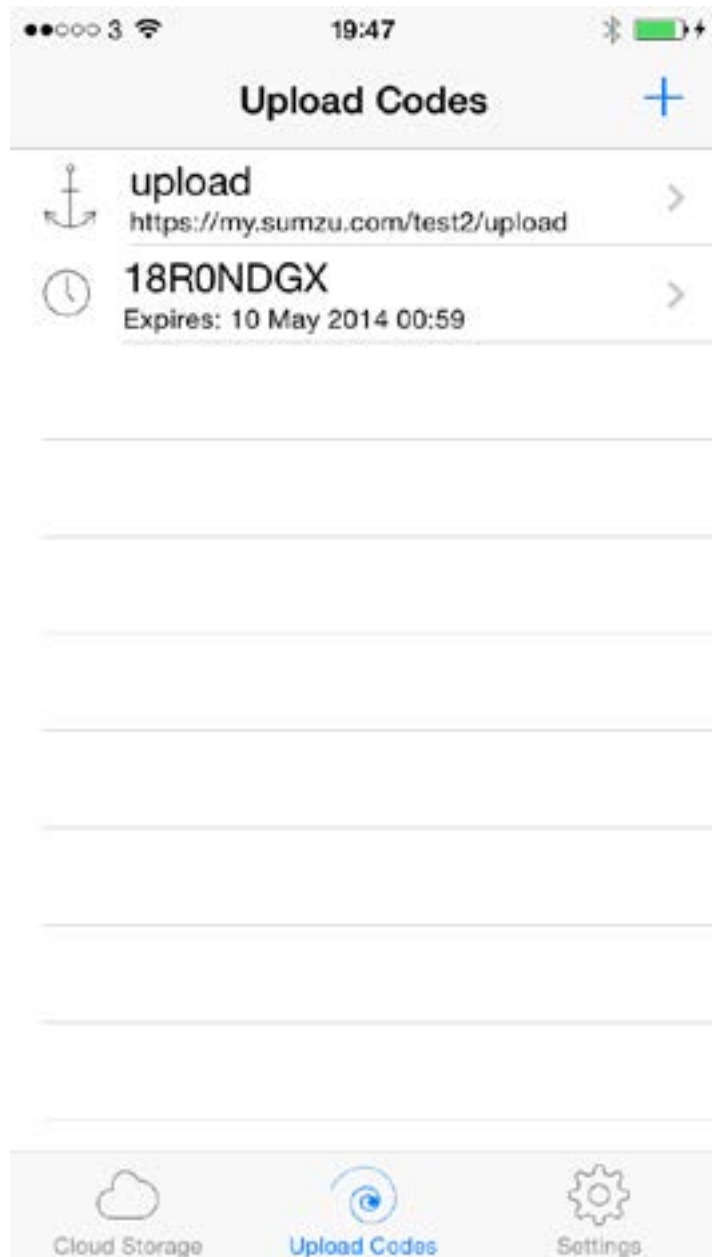

Here we see the standard login page.





This is the standard, default screen.

Each user will have a single permanent upload URL (shown by an anchor, this can be changed)

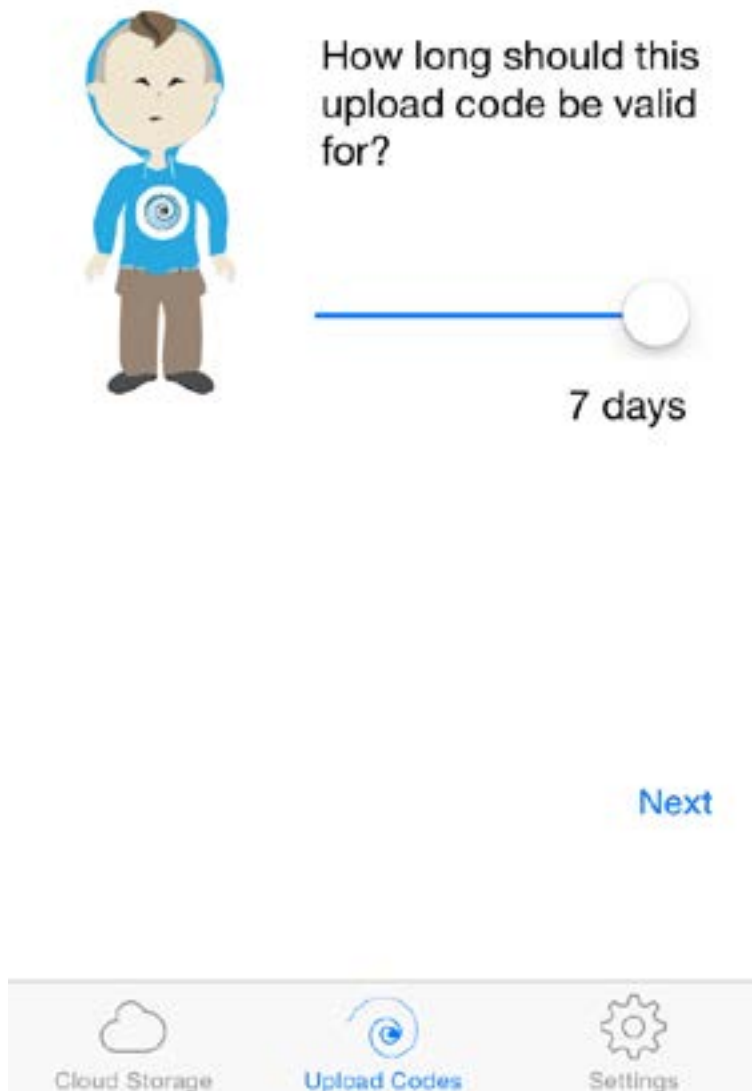
The other links can be created on demand, have an expiry date and a code. We've used a clock to show expiry but this can also be changed.

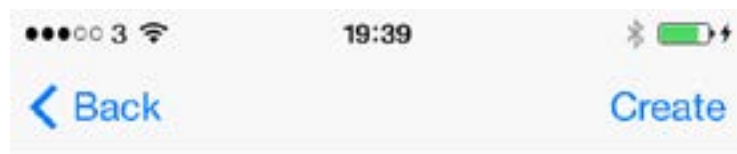
You can also see we've used a tab interface, but again this can be changed



Creating a new code is a two screen carousel on the iPhone, and is merged into one page on the iPad currently.

We use a slider to choose the expiry of the link...

Optionally we can send the upload code to someone via email - the + opens our email address.

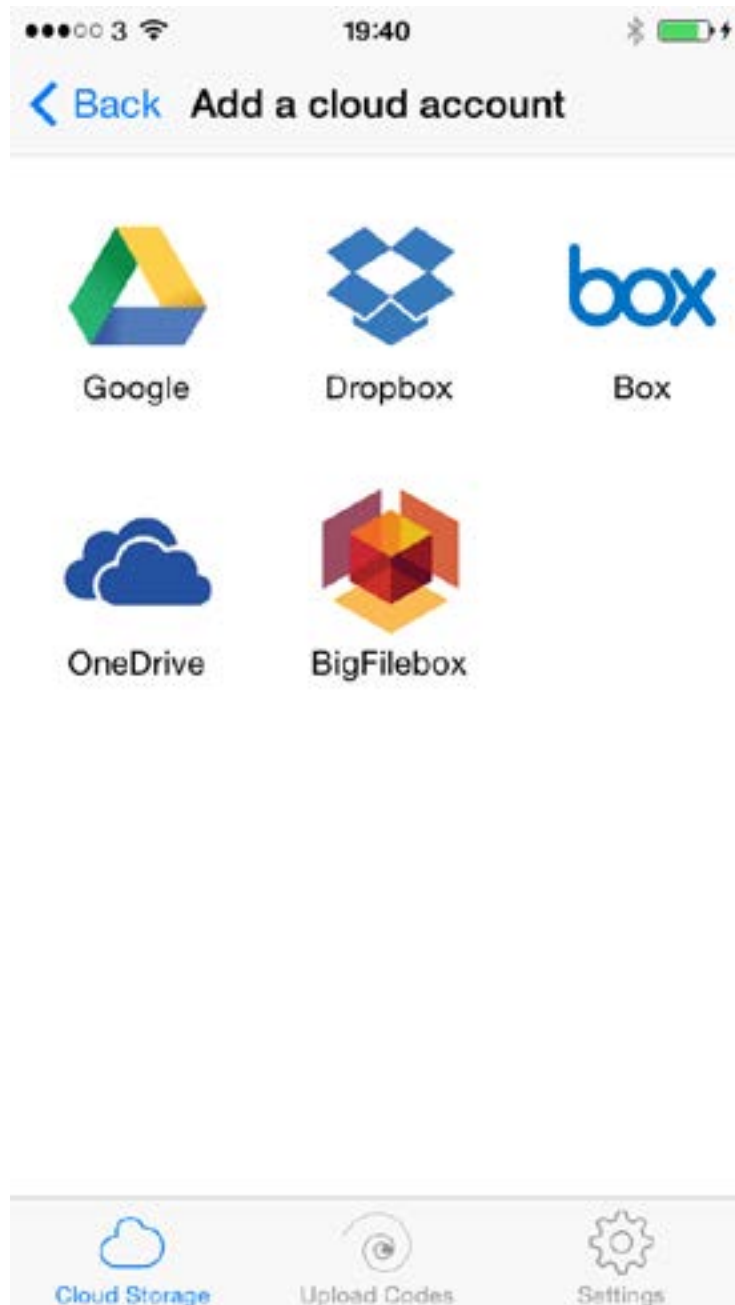

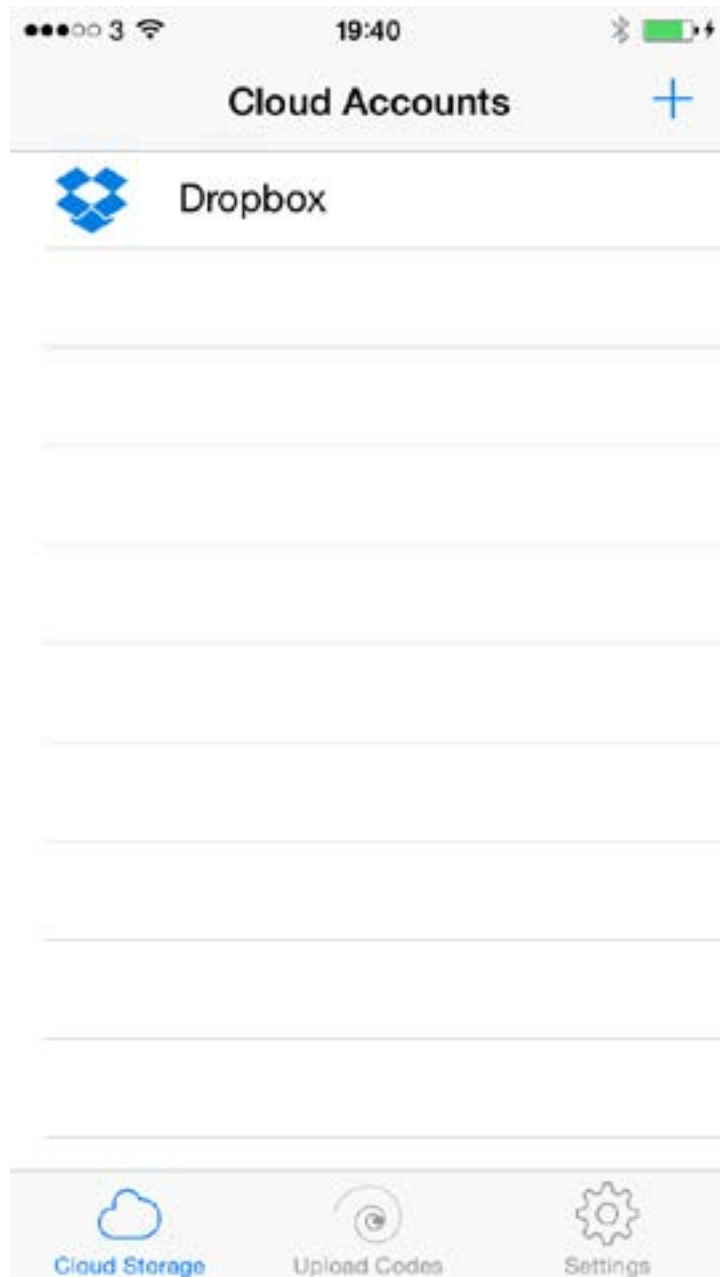


The code is generated, and can be sent via email, read over the phone, etc to the person sending files

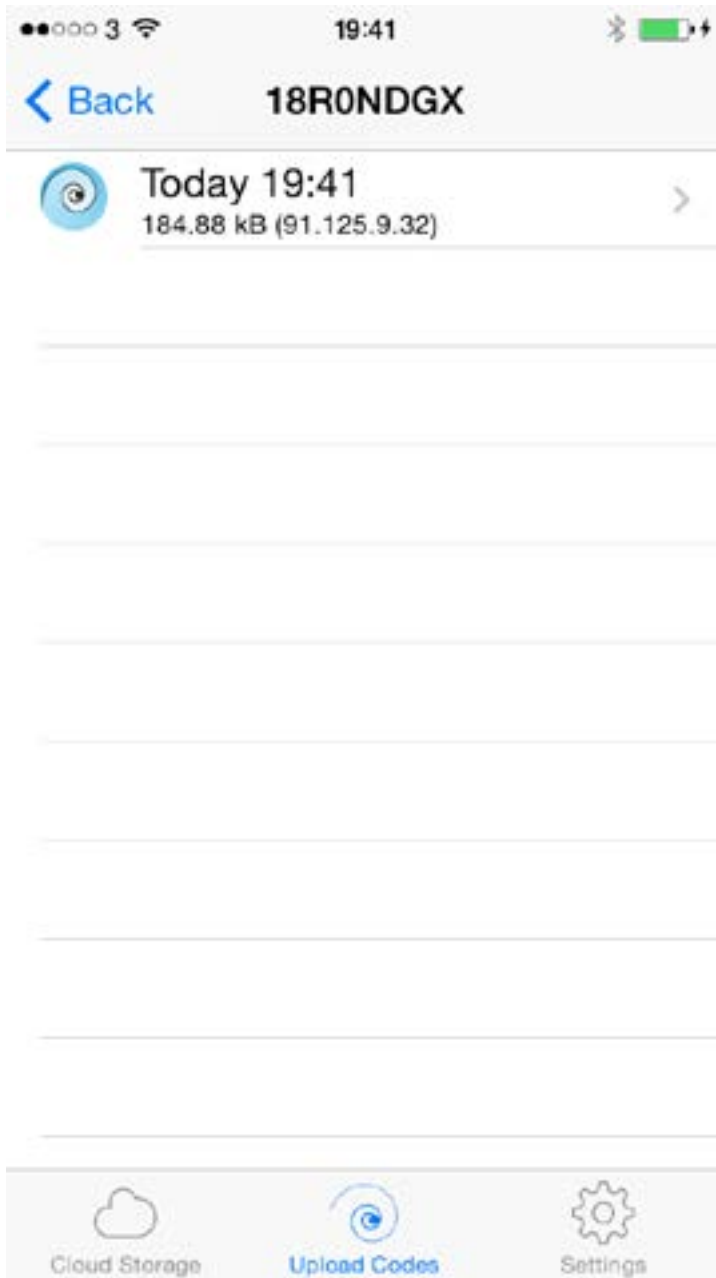


The app allows you to forward files you receive on to a cloud storage account.

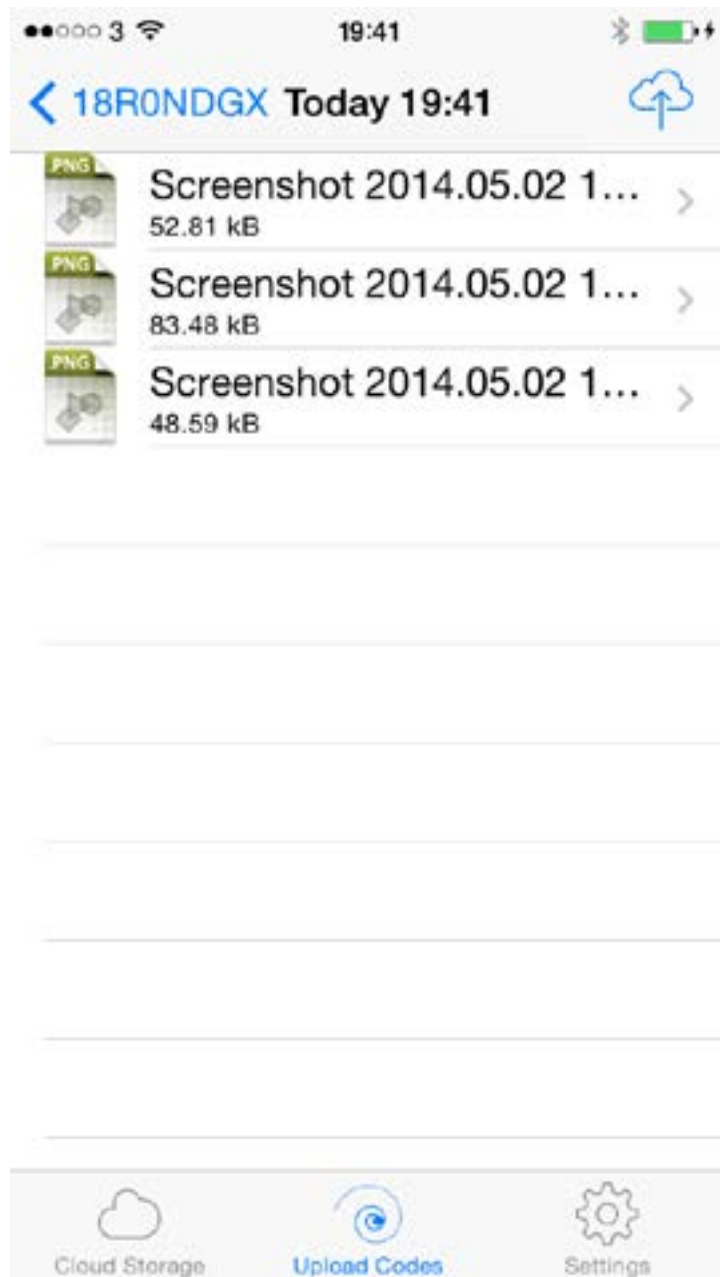
Here you choose the Cloud Storage you want to link to before you go off to the OAUTH page for the account.



Once you have connected to one or more cloud accounts they appear in this list.



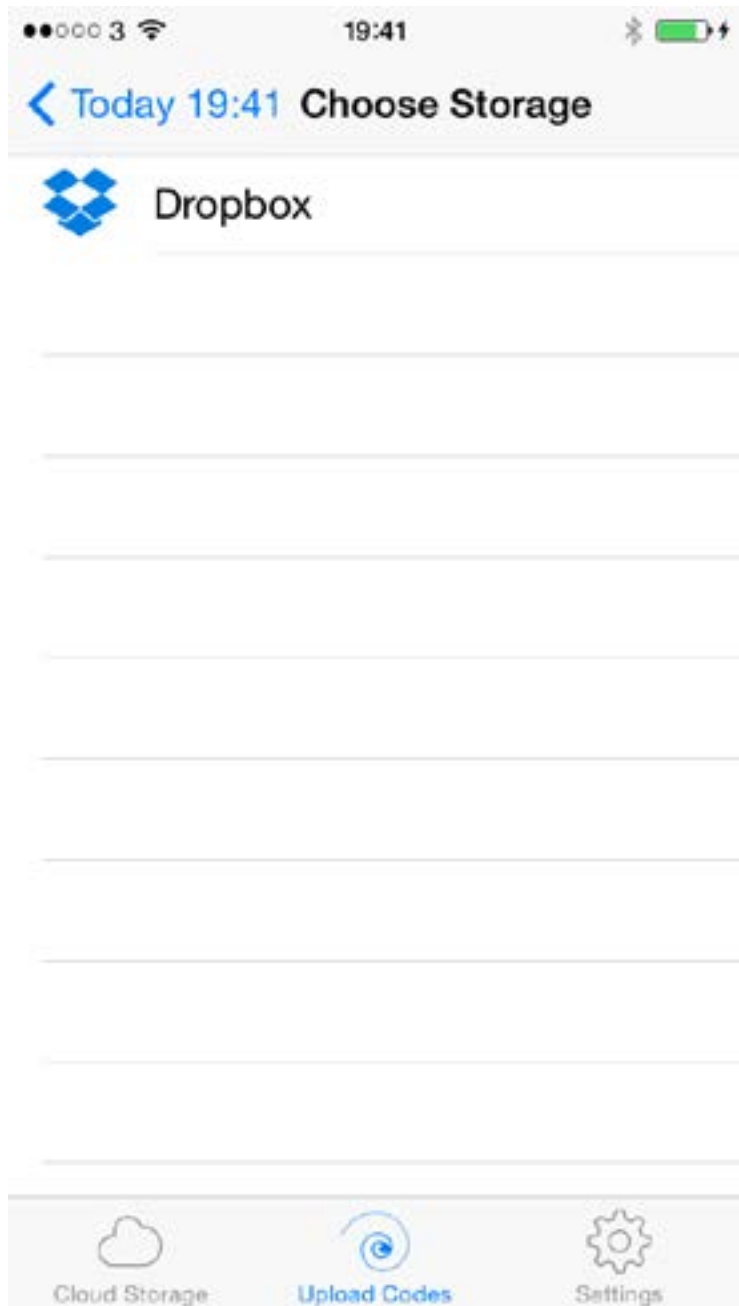
When you have received files via an upload link you can view them in the app. You may have one or more uploads per upload link/code



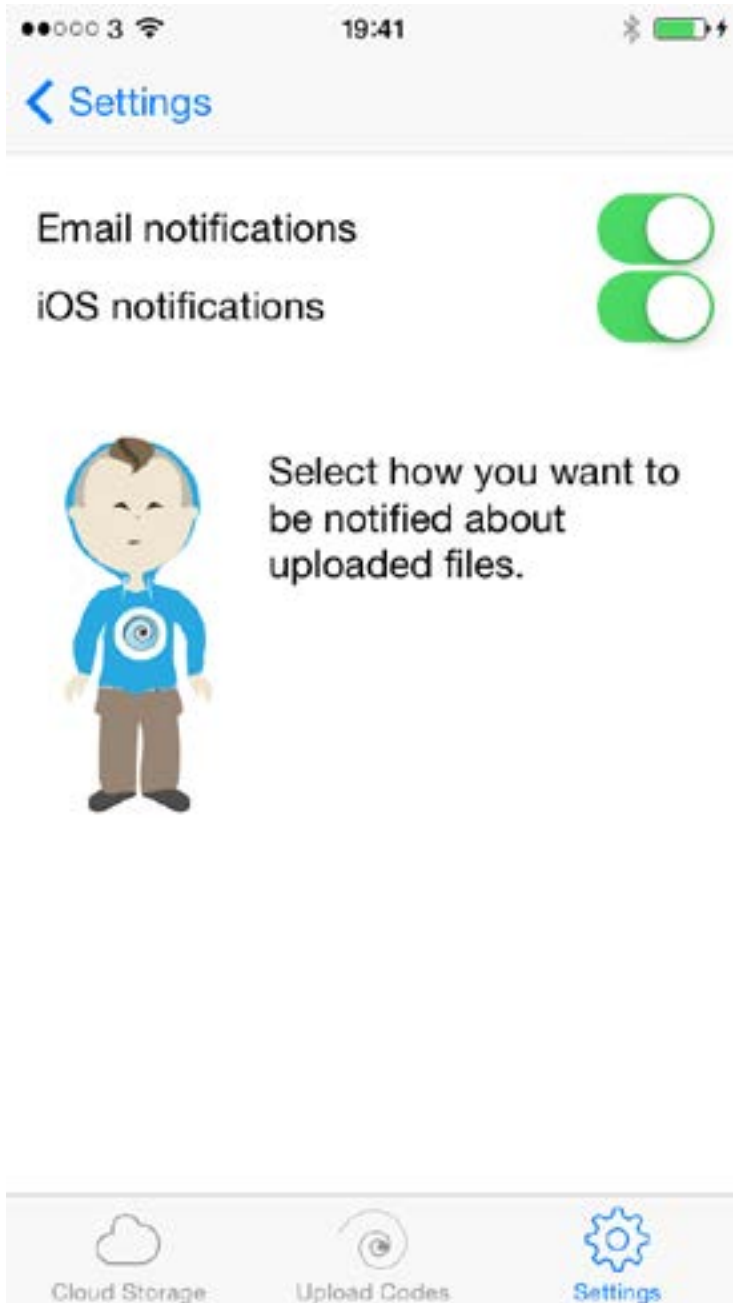
Within a specific upload you will find one or more files

Tap the file name to view it.

Tap the cloud upload icon to forward the upload to cloud storage...



...which opens this cloud storage chooser.
