Other popular San Diego attractions include the Wild Animal Park, Sea World, several outdoor and indoor concert venues, the San Diego Chargers and Padres, the artists' haven of Little Italy, whale watching and sportfishing from Shelter Island, the Cabrillo Lighthouse, historic Old Town San Diego where California was born, the Belmont Park roller coaster, the Del Mar Racetrack, the U.S.S. Midway, Seaport Village and, of course, the trendy Gaslamp Quarter, which is within a short walking distance of our new law school. The approximately 40 colleges and universities located throughout the county also offer a wide range of campus-based events.
