" It explores and plays with various issues that are relevant today - immigration, unemployment, corporate struggle, recession - and does all this in a tongue-in-cheek Bollywood format that even includes an "item" dance number.

SYNOPSIS

When Faisal, a hard working and honest Indian IT salesman in Atlanta, is laid off from his job, his troubles seem never-ending. He has massive debts and no employer wants to sponsor his work visa. Just as he is ready to give up and go back to India, his fate changes. In a wild 70s themed Indian party Faisal runs into an old childhood friend who just happens to be the recruiter for a hot new IT startup company in Atlanta, called BA-IT. Over much drinking and partying, Faisal lands a job at BA-IT. Ka-ching! Faisal is ecstatic at his good fortune.



However, things are not what they seem. Faisal is forced to sell IT services to the Atlanta mafia...and they are not buying! Faisal's very life is in danger as he struggles to figure out what else he can sell to them and how. Stuck with no other way out, Faisal is forced to make his boldest sale yet – a sale that is going to require all the persuasion and creativity he can muster, an item number and the courage to **go boldly where no salesman has gone before.**
