

## the **ADMISSION PROCESS**

The exact process for admission into The Tenney School can vary, but will typically follow the steps below:

1. **A Telephone Conference**
2. **School Overview and Tour**
3. **Student Interview**
4. **Application Submission**
5. **Placement Testing <sup>1</sup>**
6. **Student Record Review**
7. **Acceptance Decision**
8. **Deposit**
9. **Admission**
10. **Course Request**

There is no Application Fee to begin the admissions process. School Overview and Tour's are individually scheduled, and can be done by calling the school office. Once all the admissions paperwork is received and reviewed, Student Acceptances are sent out through email. A deposit is due at that point to reserve a slot for your student.

<sup>1</sup> There is a \$150 fee for placement testing administered by The Tenney School. Test results will be provided at the conclusion of testing. This fee will be refunded to families who enroll their student at The Tenney School.

Instruction is tailored in each one-to-one course to place each student in their best position for success.


One-to-one instructors factor in each student's learning strengths, weaknesses, capabilities, and needs when working with students.
