

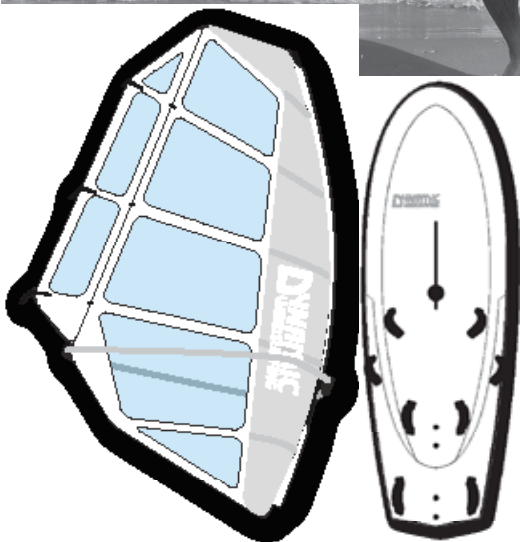




Dynamic Windsurfing allows you to take full advantage of the uniquely varying nature of the sport.

surfer can take full advantage of the uniquely varying nature of the sport. Dynamic windsurfing provides perfect windsurfing under all conditions. The seasoned sailor will be kept happy with windsurfing as varied as nature and the weather itself. Windsurfing trips (or sessions with friends) can be planned a long time ahead and you can relax because you will always have suitable equipment whatever the weather.

The advantages of Dynamic Windsurfing.

Windsurfing is an exhilarating sport that works in harmony with nature. Every time on the water is unique depending on variations in the weather conditions, the location and your sailing abilities. This is what makes the sport truly enjoyable, varied and challenging. With Dynamic Windsurfing you will always have an appropriate board shape and sail size for the prevailing condition.

When you buy a traditional board, your choice limits your surfing to particular conditions. Should you buy a board for light winds, strong winds or something in between? One day can be perfect but the next day can be a disaster. Having a sail that is too large can make sailing feel like a wrestling match with a much too strong opponent. An oversized board will be jumpy and difficult to control at high speeds and in choppy waters. An undersized sail or board can either leave you sitting ashore waiting for wind or trying to stand on the board knee-deep in water.


You may end up spending more time monitoring wind forecasts and deciding whether or not you can get out on the water than actually getting windsurfing action. The risk is that your gear just collects dust waiting for the right conditions. Buying several traditional boards and sails creates problems with transport, storage and costs.

The inexperienced


windsurfer is provided with the equipment he needs to improve. Start sailing with the largest board shapes and smallest sail sizes. Build up useful basic techniques with these shapes in light winds. Have the freedom to experiment with smaller shapes when the wind picks up. The inexperienced sailor will soon enter the exciting world of small board surfing.

The family/surf school

will have a windsurfing board suitable for all members. Even if the boards were bought mainly for beginners, the experienced surfers will also be keen on Dynamic Windsurfing and will be first in line for the gear on windy days. Everyone will be happy with the investment.

The XL-board's shape works perfectly for lighter wind conditions. For more experienced sailors the XL board combined with the largest sail size is an excellent way to enjoy windsurfing on those many sunny and beautiful non-extreme days. Perfect for sailing longer distances or training light-wind sailing techniques. Include some pumping and you will even get a real workout..

The XL shape is the same as the L shape but with a critical difference, besides the skeg (fin) the XL also has a centre fin. The centre fin is an important feature as it adds stability, decreases downwind drifting and greatly improves the board's performance when sailing upwind.

The XL shape combined with a smaller sail size is a perfect combination for beginners.

By simply removing the centre fin you have the L board. This improves the boards planing abilities. Just a small gust of wind will accelerate the board onto the surface of the water (plane) and enable speeds exceeding 15 knots.

The seasoned sailor will enjoy this board shape even in stronger winds, especially in gusty or flatwater conditions, as the shape maximizes you average speed. For intermediate sailors this board is the perfect design for learning and improving your planing techniques.

The L-shape is wide at the stern and has a large skeg. With the L you can point close to the wind at planing speeds and sailing deep downwind.

M for medium winds

The M-board's shape gives full planing capabilities, great response and fast turns.

M is perfect for advanced and intermediate sailors. Perfect for training water starts, foot steer the board, make body drags, practice planing jibes or just try to outrun other sailors on the water! Importantly, you still have enough board volume to comfortably uphaul the rig and sail if the wind drops, so getting back to shore is no problem.

The bow of the M-shape has relatively large volume in order to keep steady and enhance early planing. The narrower tail gives a smaller wet surface when planing resulting in higher topspeeds. M uses only the back fin and has no centre fin.

S for strong winds

You don't get a gale-force wind every day, but when you do, you don't want to miss it. Full speed, fast turns and high adrenaline.

For strong winds or waves, this is the ideal board shape. You can choose whether you want to set your next speed record, do high jumps or pull off that laydown jibe.

S is shaped like a classic sinker and demands precision in both foot placement and overall sailing technique. S is sailed by fin planing alone.

Vacumlaminated carbon sandwich board for low weight and stiffness.

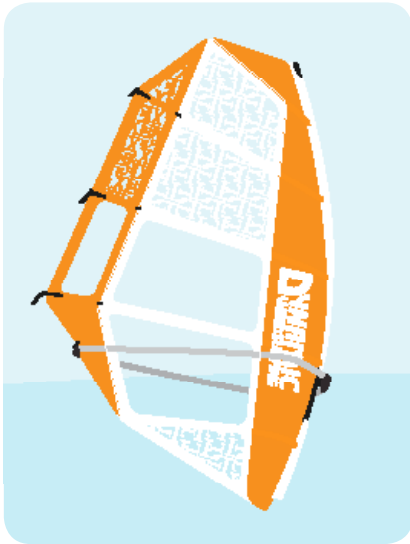

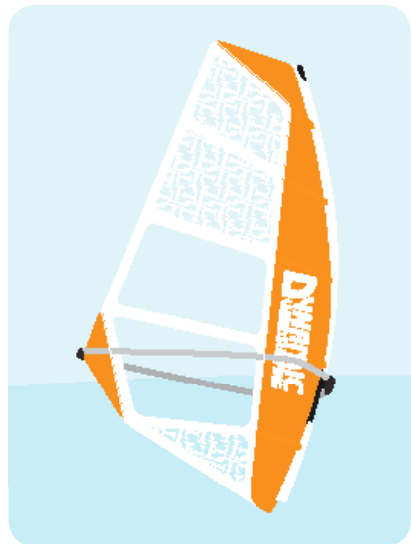
XL for extra light winds



The XL-size is suitable for extremely light wind. Only a small gust of wind is needed for planing. The XL is also perfect for heavier or seasoned sailors who can use the sail in stronger winds to maximize power in combination with smaller board shapes.

L for large winds



The size L is great for lighter winds. It adds another option depending on the current conditions. For example, in gusty or choppy conditions, this sail size combined with a small board shape can give just the right amount of extra power to keep planing.

Harness adaptable to surf conditions. Waist harness for high performance control, sitting harness for optimal race position. One size fits all.



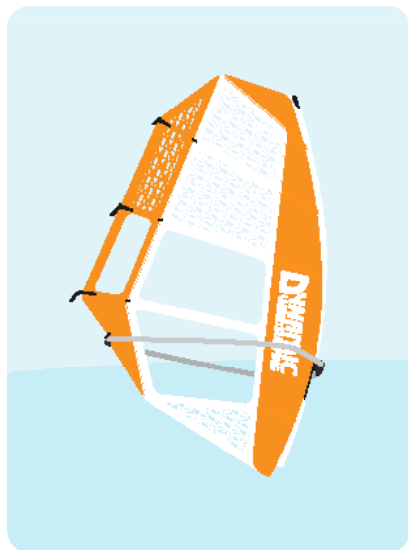
Harness line, length adjustable while sailing.

M for medium winds



Sail size M is for medium winds. The heavier/seasoned surfer uses this sail in windier conditions than the light/inexperienced surfer. Combines with a suitable board shape, depending on prevailing wind, waves, surfer weight and technique.

S for strong winds



In strong winds and large waves, the experienced surfer preferably uses sail size S together with board form S. The beginner uses sail size S in combination with board form XL in light wind.
